WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and City Council to explore options with public and private school systems for expansion of a parks and recreation system; and

WHEREAS, such partnerships may result in expanded services to residents and constituents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THIS COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA, AND IT IS RESOLVED BY THE AUTHORITY OF SAID CITY COUNCIL.
