BUSINESS COMMUNITIES SERVED WITHIN THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS;

WHEREAS, the City of Sandy Springs is committed to maintaining compliance for all Alcoholic Beverage licensees that are bestowed a mere privilege to carry on the business during the term of the license, subject to all terms and conditions imposed by the Sandy Springs Code of Ordinances and State law; and

WHEREAS, this license is subject to be revoked and annulled, and is subject to any further ordinances which may be enacted; and

WHEREAS, the City is interested in obtaining input from residents and the business community to best identify the needs of constituents and the City; and


WHEREAS, a committee comprised of community volunteers, staff, and businesses will be formed to complete this review in coordination with the City Manager's Office.


