WHEREAS, a committee comprised of community volunteers will form a task force in coordination with the City Manager for identifying and recommending projects suitable for the range of volunteer skills and interest that exist in our community to complete this review; and


WHEREAS, with the right effort our City can earn the sobriquet "Sandy Springs – the city that volunteers."
