RESOLUTION NO. 2006-05-48

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF A H.E.A.T. GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2007-2008 FOR THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA.

Whereas, a proposed budget for the creation of a H.E.A.T. (Highway Enforcement Aggressive Traffic) Unit for D.U.I. enforcement has been developed for City Council approval; and

Whereas, appropriate grant documents are required to be submitted by the grant application deadline of May 26, 2006; and

Whereas, the Mayor and City Council have reviewed the proposed budget and concur that this type of specialized law enforcement unit is in the best interest of the citizens of Sandy Springs; and

Whereas, the appropriate grant fund has a balanced budget, such that anticipated funding sources equal or exceed proposed expenditures; and

Now, therefore, the Mayor and Council of the City of Sandy Springs, pursuant to their authority, do hereby adopt the following Resolution:

1.

The City of Sandy Springs, Georgia hereby submits a H.E.A.T. Grant application for D.U.I. enforcement for the Fiscal Year 2007-2008, said budget shown on Attachment "A" for the grant fund of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia;

Any increase or decrease in appropriations or revenue or department; other than those exceptions provided within the grant document, shall require approval of Mayor and City Council; and

3.

The City Manager and his/her designee may promulgate all necessary internal rules, regulations, and policies to ensure that this Authorizing Resolution is followed.
