A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT AND APPROVE THE ACCEPTANCE OF MAINTENANCE OF ELECTRICALLY OPERATED TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES ON STATE ROUTES FOR THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, it is necessary, from time to time, to establish policies, procedures and guidelines consistent with the administration of a municipal government consistent with the US Constitution, Federal Statutes, alignment with Federal, Georgia's State Constitution, and the Charter for the City of Sandy Springs and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works in response to the guidance provided by the City Manager has requested the acceptance of Electrical Traffic Control Device maintenance on state routes in order to provide timely maintenance response.

WHEREAS the City Manager directed the Department of Public Works to develop standard policies for recurring matters, to establish appropriate internal controls and legal compliance, and to provide for an efficient and effective means to serve constituents; and

WHEREAS, upon adoption of this Resolution, staff will assume the Electrical Traffic Control Device maintenance into the City's management program to effectuate the management of Department of Public Works, Transportation Division's Traffic Signal, School Flasher and Overhead Beacon maintenance program; and

WHEREAS, the City resolves to utilize these operational policies, procedures, and guidelines in all applications of its Electrical Traffic Control Device maintenance on state routes.

WHEREAS, for the purposes of this document, the term Traffic Control Devices shall mean, Traffic Signals, School Flashers and Overhead Flashing Beacons.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA. That the City of Sandy Springs City Council and the Mayor, accepts and affirms the Operational Policies, Procedures and Guidelines as issued by the City Manager.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Sandy Springs City Council and the Mayor authorizes the City Manager or his Designee in order to assure the effectiveness of the Program now and in the future will periodically refine and update the Traffic Control Device Maintenance Program on behalf of the City and Georgia DOT to develop, implement and carry out the Traffic Control Device maintenance for the City of Sandy Springs. The maintenance of Traffic Control Devices on state routes includes the authority for the City Manager or his Designee to execute permits for state traffic control device permits, on behalf of the City.

The City Manager shall oversee the Department of Public Works' administration of the Traffic Control Device Maintenance Program. The City Manager also will recommend a Program Budget which reflects the appropriate and sufficient funding necessary to support the effective operations of the Traffic Control Devices for the City of Sandy Springs
