

**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE REFERENDUM FOR THE  
SPECIAL ELECTION ON JULY 18, 2006**

**WHEREAS**, in the 2006 Session of the Georgia General Assembly, HB 1034, Act 676, HB 1035, Act 679, HB 1036, Act 682, HB 1037, Act 683, HB 1038, Act 709, and HB 1039, Act 710 were adopted (the "Acts"), which Acts provide for residential homestead exemptions, conditioned upon voter approval; and,


**WHEREAS**, there is called to be held in the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2006, on the same date as the statewide general primary conducted in 2006, a Special Election for the purpose of submitting the Acts to the electors of the City of Sandy Springs for approval or rejection; and,

**WHEREAS**, the application of these residential homestead exemptions will be of great financial benefit to the residents of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia.


