**A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT AND APPROVE THE STREET NAME SIGN TOPPER
GUIDELINES FOR THE CITY OF SANDY SPRING AND TO PROVIDE FOR GUIDANCE IN
ADMINISTERING SUCH POLICY**

WHEREAS, it is necessary, from time to time, to establish policies, procedures and guidelines consistent with the administration of a municipal government consistent with the US Constitution, Federal Statutes, alignment with Federal, Georgia's State Constitution, and the Charter for the City of Sandy Springs; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works, in response to the guidance provided by the City Manager has comprehensively developed the Guidelines for Street Name Sign Toppers in order to promote community identity;

WHEREAS the City Manager directed the Department of Public Works to develop standard policies for recurring matters, to establish appropriate internal controls and legal compliance, and to provide for an efficient and effective means to serve constituents; and

WHEREAS, upon adoption of this Resolution, staff will incorporate the Street Name Sign Topper Guidelines into the City's management program to effectuate the management of Department of Public Works, Street Name Sign Topper Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the City resolves to utilize these operational policies, procedures, and guidelines in all applications of its Sign Topper requests.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA:**

That the City of Sandy Springs Mayor and City Council receives, accepts and affirms the Operational Policies, Procedures and Guidelines as issued by the City Manager and further designates the Director of the Department of Public Works as his Designee to develop, implement and carry out the Sign Topper Guidelines for the City of Sandy Springs; and

That the City Manager shall oversee the administration of the Sign Topper Guidelines developed by the Department of Public Works. The acquisition, installation, maintenance and replacement of the sign toppers are the responsibility of the Requester. The City of Sandy Springs is only approving and adopting the Guidelines for the Sign Topper. The City of Sandy Springs is hereby released from any liability arising from installation of the signs.


