A RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE ENFORCEMENT OF A PROVISION OF THE LAND DEVELOPMENT AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION CODES OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS: CHAPTER 14, ARTICLE XXXIII, SIGNS, SECTION 33.5r RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION OF CARAVAN REAL ESTATE SIGNS

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council for the City of Sandy Springs, GA while in regular session on August 1, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. as follows:

SECTION 1. That enforcement of Zoning Ordinance of the City of Sandy Springs, Chapter 14, Article XXXIII, Section 33.5r, relating to the prohibition signs not specifically permitted by the Ordinance shall be suspended as the same pertains to prohibiting the use signs directing licensed real estate agents to newly listed housing, posted only on Tuesday of each week between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. which signs are commonly known as caravan signs, not to exceed 4 square feet in size, shall be suspended until the expiration of the current calendar year, or until further action by the City Council pertaining to this matter which ever shall first occur.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall not affect the enforcement or enforceability of any other City Ordinance as the same relates to prohibiting the use of any sign not specifically authorized under the Ordinance of the City of Sandy Springs, all of which prohibition shall, otherwise, remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.


