**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE RIGHT-OF-WAY POLICY
FOR THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS; TO PROVIDE FOR GUIDANCE IN
ADMINISTERING SUCH POLICY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, it is necessary, from time to time, to establish policies, procedures and guidelines consistent with the administration of a municipal government in alignment with the US Constitution, Federal Statues, Georgia's State Constitution, and the Charter for the City of Sandy Springs and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works in response to the guidance provided by the City Manager has comprehensively developed the Right-of-Way Policy in order to provide guidance and direction to City officials and employees.

WHEREAS the City Manager directed the Department of Public Works to develop standard policies for recurring matters, to establish appropriate internal controls and legal compliance, and to provide for an efficient and effective means to serve constituents; and

WHEREAS, upon adoption of this Resolution, staff will incorporate the Right-of-Way Policy into the City's management program to effectuate the management of Department of Public Works, Transportation Division's Right-of-Way policies; and

WHEREAS, the City resolves to utilize these operational policies, procedures, and guidelines in all applications of Right-of-Way requests.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA.

That the City of Sandy Springs City Council and the Mayor receives, accepts and affirms the Operational Policies, Procedures and Guidelines as issued by the City Manager and further designated the Director of the Department of Public Works as his Designee to develop, implement and carry out the Right-of-Way Policy for the City of Sandy Springs.

That the City Manager shall oversee the administration of the Right-of-Way Policy developed by the Department of Public Works. The City Manager will recommend a Program Budget which reflects the appropriate and sufficient funding necessary to support an effective Right-of Way Program for the City of Sandy Springs


