**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A BUSINESS OCCUPATIONAL TAX AMNESTY PROGRAM
WAIVING PENALTIES AND INTEREST FOR NEW BUSINESSES IN SANDY SPRINGS
THROUGH MARCH 31, 2007**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council approved a Revenue Enhancement Program on July 18, 2006; and

WHEREAS, as part of the comprehensive field inspection, review and analysis of existing databases, there are many businesses in Sandy Springs in operation without an Occupational Tax Certificate; and

WHEREAS, the approach and methodology to create the Sandy Springs business database is being conducted in an courteous, considerate, and unobtrusive manner with the knowledgeable of the sensitivity to the business community; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to allow adequate time for compliance with Chapter 11, Business and Occupation Taxes of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Sandy Springs, the Mayor and Council wish to waive the penalties and interest for new businesses in the City of Sandy Springs; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia that a Business Occupational Tax Amnesty Program is established hereby waiving the penalties and interest for new businesses in Sandy Springs until March 31, 2007.


