**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS ACCEPTING THE MOTIONS AND
ACTIONS TAKEN BY THE GOVERNOR'S COMMISSION OF SANDY SPRINGS; AND
DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO PROVIDE A CERTIFIED COPY TO FULTON COUNTY,
GEORGIA**

WHEREAS, the Governor's Commission of Sandy Springs was created and members appointed on January 24, 2005, for the purposes of facilitating the needs of the new municipality upon the adoption of house bill 36 and 37 of the Georgia legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Governor's Commission operated in an efficient and effective manner to carry out it's intended purpose; and

WHEREAS, during regularly scheduled meetings, the members of the commission voted on action items to define business and operational issues.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that all actions taken by the Governor's Commission are hereby accepted by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia shall be in effect as if they had been passed by the Mayor and City Council.

Such action items are defined below

June 29, 2005

The motion was made by James Burgess and seconded by Ray Smith for the Commission's negotiating team to take the position that all assets purchased by the Special Services District Taxes are owned by Sandy Springs and that assets paid for out of the Fulton County General Fund are to be negotiated. After discussion, the motion was unanimously approved.

July 6, 2005

Whereas the citizens of the community of Sandy Springs will have duly paid taxes to Fulton County for the year 2005, it is the obligation of the County to continue all services until the end of said year, with the exception of any services that this Commission notifies the County that the City is ready to assume in December.

October 18, 2005

Notification to Fulton County on services to be assumed by City

In addition to services/functions previously identified to be assumed by the City of Sandy Springs on December 1, 2005, the City is expected to assume other services/functions on January 1, 2006. A list of the services to be assumed by the City on 1/1/06 will be prepared by October 25, 2005 and then given to the GCSS. This list will exclude fire, police, and E911 and will be given to Fulton County by 11/1/05. The motion to prepare such a list to meet the above schedule was made by Chairman Porter, seconded by Commissioner Smith and passed unanimously.

November 2, 2005

Notification to Tax Collector

Commissioner Porter made the motion to notify the Fulton County Tax Commissioner to hold in escrow all 2006 fees and licenses collected during 2005 on properties located in the newly incorporated area of Sandy Springs until the City Officials are seated in December 2005. This action is subject to legal review. Commissioner Kirschner seconded the motion and it passed unanimously

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED BY THIS COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA, AND IT IS RESOLVED BY THE AUTHORITY OF SAID CITY COUNCIL.

By passage of this resolution, the actions taken by the Governor's Commission of Sandy Springs are accepted by the Mayor and City Council of Sandy Springs.
