**A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE PREQUALIFICATION OF REGISTERED  
PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS WHO MAY PERFORM INSPECTIONS PURSUANT TO  
O.C.G.A. § 8-2-26(g)(7).**

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council for the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia while in regular session on December 20, 2005 at 7:00 p.m. as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That the Mayor and City Council intend to provide for the prequalification of registered professional engineers who may perform inspections pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 8-2-26; and,


**SECTION 2.** That the qualifications of a registered engineer shall be evaluated on the basis of the engineer's expertise with respect to the objectives of the inspection, as demonstrated by the engineer's experience, education, and training; and,

**SECTION 3.** That this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Council does authorize and direct the Mayor and the City Attorney to have published a notice in the city's legal organ in the form as attached hereto as Appendix 1, informing the public of the Council's intention to require prequalification of registered professional engineers who may perform inspections pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 8-2-26.

**Public Notice**
