**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE ADMINISTRATION,  
FINANCE, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, TRANSPORTATION, PUBLIC WORKS,  
POLICE, FIRE, PARKS AND RECREATION, AND BUILDING DEPARTMENTS ACCORDING  
TO CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 4, SECTION 1 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE  
CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GA**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sandy Springs is a Georgia municipal corporation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council are the governing authority of the City of Sandy Springs; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 2.01 of the Charter of the City of Sandy Springs provides that all legislative authority for the City of Sandy Springs shall be vested in the Mayor and City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 1.03 of the Charter of the City of Sandy Springs provides for the creation of departments by the Mayor and City Council for the provision of various governmental functions throughout the City of Sandy Springs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council have determined that it is in the best interest of the public and promotes the public health, safety and welfare to create departments within the City of Sandy Springs to provide such governmental functions:

**NOW, THEREFORE**, to accomplish the foregoing, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia, pursuant to their authority, do hereby adopt the following ordinance:

1.

The Code of Ordinances of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia is hereby amended by creating a new Section to read as follows:

Chapter 2: Administration

Article 4: City Departments

*Section 1: Authorization*

The following departments are established by the Council:

- (a) Administration
- (b) Finance
- (c) Community Development
- (d) Transportation
- (e) Public Works
- (f) Police
- (g) Fire
- (h) Parks and Recreation
- (i) Building

2.

All ordinances, parts of ordinances, or regulations in conflict herewith are repealed.

3.

*Severability.* Should any court of competent jurisdiction declare any section of this Ordinance invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any other part thereof, which is not specifically declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.

4.

*Renumbering.* It is the intention of the Mayor and City Council, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia, and the sections of this Ordinance may be numbered or renumbered to accomplish such intention.
