

COUNTY OF FULTON

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 14(g) OF ARTICLE 1 OF CHAPTER 7  
ON ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF  
THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS SO AS TO NO LONGER ALLOW  
APPLICATIONS FOR TRANSFER OF A LOCATION**

**WHEREAS**, Section 14(g) of Article 1 of Chapter 7 of the Code of Ordinances currently provides that a licensee under Chapter 7 may apply for a transfer of location and that if approved and if there is no change of ownership, the license fee previously paid shall be applied to the new location, although a transfer fee must be paid; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and the City Council have determined that an application for a transfer of location requires the same location and other considerations as any original application for a license to sell alcoholic beverages; and

**WHEREAS**, as currently written, this provision, although requiring approval of the new location, appears to by-pass the advertising and hearing requirements otherwise applicable to the issuance of an original license for a specified location;


**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Sandy Springs do hereby adopt this Ordinance so that Section 14(g) of Article 1 of Chapter 7 is hereby stricken in its entirety and in its place the following shall appear and be known hereafter as Section 14(g) of Article 1 of Chapter 7 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Sandy Springs:

**“Section 14: Transferability of license**

- (g) **Should a licensee desire to change the location of the licensed premises, a new application for a license to sell alcoholic beverages shall be completed and filed as to the new location and shall be subject to all requirements and proceedings as for the issuance of any new license under and as provided in this Chapter.”**
