

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 10(a) OF ARTICLE 1 OF CHAPTER 11  
ON BUSINESS OCCUPATION TAX, LICENSES, AND REGULATION OF THE  
CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS SO AS TO ALLOW  
APPLICATIONS FOR TRANSFER OF A BUSINESS LICENSE**

**WHEREAS**, Section 10(a) of Article 1 of Chapter 11 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Sandy Springs (the "Code of Ordinances") provides that no certificate issued thereunder may be transferred and that any new business or practitioner shall apply and register for a new certificate within 30 days after the commencement of business; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Sandy Springs have determined that it is appropriate to allow the transfer of a business license under certain circumstances;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Sandy Springs do hereby adopt this Ordinance so that Section 10(a) of Article 1 of Chapter 11 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby stricken in its entirety and in its place the following shall appear and be known hereafter as Section 10(a) of Article 1 of Chapter 11 of the Code of Ordinances:

**“(a) Transfer of License.**

**(i) New Location**

**(A) Any business or practitioner subject to this Article moving from one location to another location within the city limits of the City of Sandy Springs shall notify the City of Sandy Springs of such move and of the new address in writing, on a form provided by the City of Sandy Springs, no later than thirty (30) days prior to the date that the business or practitioner moves to the new location.**

**(B) A new certificate will be issued upon payment of a change of location fee if the new location conforms to the building and zoning regulations of the City of Sandy Springs. The amount of the change of location fee shall be established as part of the schedule of fees as approved by the City Council of the City of Sandy Springs from time to time.**

- (ii) **New Owner.** No certificate issued hereunder may be transferred to any other person, partnership, corporation, business, practitioner or other entity. Any new business owner or practitioner shall apply and register for a new certificate within 30 days after the commencement of business.”
