**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE 19, USE PERMITS, SECTION 19.4.18.,
EQUINE GARMENT FABRICATION, OF THE SANDY SPRINGS ZONING
ORDINANCE**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Sandy Springs find that from time to time it is necessary to amend sections of the Zoning Ordinance to correct, clarify, and update the provisions of the Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of Sandy Springs have determined in districts zoned for agriculture, a Use Permit to run an Equine Garment Fabrication operation is no longer relevant and necessary because this type of fabrication would be allowed, as a Millinery, in C-1, Community Business Districts, and in M, Industrial Districts; and

THEREFORE, to accomplish the foregoing, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia, pursuant to their authority, do hereby adopt the following Ordinance:

1.

Article 19, *Use Permits*, Section 19.4.18., *Equine Garment Fabrication*, of the City of Sandy Springs Zoning Ordinance is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following inserted therefor:

19.4.18 OPEN

2.

All ordinances, parts of ordinances, or regulations in conflict herewith are repealed.

3.

Severability. Should any court of competent jurisdiction declare any section of this Ordinance invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, which is not specifically declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.

4.

Repeal of Conflicting Provisions. It is the intention of the Mayor and Council, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances, City of Sandy Springs, Georgia and the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish such intention.


