**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AN APPLICATION SUBMISSION TO THE FY2015
EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) GRANT
PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant Program ("JAG") of the Office of Justice Programs provides funding to support all components of the criminal justice system, ranging from multijurisdictional task forces to crime prevention and domestic violence programs, courts, corrections, treatment, and justice information sharing initiatives; and

WHEREAS, JAG has notified the City of Sandy Springs it is eligible to receive a grant award of \$14,307 for eligible requests; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic and K9 Unit of the Sandy Springs Police Department is in need of replacing aging speed-detection devices; and


WHEREAS, the procurement of speed-detection devices is an eligible cost under the JAG grant program.
