AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE XII-B, SANDY SPRINGS OVERLAY DISTRICT,
OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS ZONING ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Sandy Springs are charged with the protection of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Sandy Springs; and

WHEREAS, the State of Georgia authorizes the City of Sandy Springs to exercise regulations where it sees fit to maintain the safety and welfare of the citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has on several previous occasions identified and documented the negative secondary effects of adult establishments and hereby incorporates its previous findings and legislative record materials concerning such effects; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Sandy Springs find that from time to time it is appropriate to amend sections of the Code to correct, clarify, and update the provisions of the Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City regulates the location of adult establishments through Section 19.3.1 of the Sandy Springs Zoning Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that provisions in Article XII-B concerning the permissibility of adult establishments in overlay districts should be clarified; and

NOW, THEREFORE, to accomplish the foregoing, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia, pursuant to their authority, do hereby adopt the following Ordinance:

1.

Section 12B.7.A.a, *Sandy Springs Overlay District, Prohibited Uses, All Districts*, of the Sandy Springs Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended as shown in the attached mark-up.

2.

All ordinances, parts of ordinances, or regulations in conflict herewith are repealed.

3.

Severability. Should any court of competent jurisdiction declare any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, which is not specifically declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.

4.

Repeal of Conflicting Provisions. It is the intention of the Mayor and City Council, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made part of the Code of


Ordinances, City of Sandy Springs, Georgia and the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish such intention.
