

Week in Review: Week Ending 8-19-2016

PUBLIC SAFETY

SSPD

North District

Crime:

- The Unit reported seven residential burglaries and two commercial burglaries for the week:
 - The residential burglaries occurred throughout the district, with the majority occurring inside apartment complexes including Spring Creek Ln, Jefferson Drive, Greyfield Lane, and 7000 Roswell Road.
- The Unit reported 17 *entering autos* for the week:
 - The incidents occurred throughout the district and included locations in the 6000 and 8000 blocks of Roswell Road, one in the Peachtree Dunwoody Road hotel district, Vernon Woods Drive & Cherry Tree Lane, Spring Creek Lane, and one incident at 1600 Dunwoody Club Drive.

Community:

- Officer Godfrey attended an HOA/Neighborhood Watch meeting at Carroll Manor Subdivision with approximately 15 residents. Residents in attendance, many who were residents prior to the city's incorporation, thanked SSPD for the excellent service and response the department provides. Recent area crime trends, as well as crime prevention tips, were discussed during the meeting.
- CRASE (Civilian Response to Active Shooter Events) classes were taught by Officers Godfrey and Begeal:
 - Holy Innocent's School for approximately 300 faculty and staff.
 - ROAM (1155 Mount Vernon Highway) with approximately 45 attendees.

South District

Crime:

- Three 17-year-old students at Riverwood High School were arrested on August 12 after brandishing two weapons at a construction employee who was managing traffic control at the intersection of Heards Drive/Raider Drive and Powers Ferry Road. The three drove past the construction site several times after the original call. Officer Voronkov spotted a car matching the description and suspect description and conducted a felony stop on Powers Ferry, thirty yards from the original complaint site. Two weapons were recovered. As the three suspects were being questioned, another call of "shots fired" came from the River Edge parking decks. The suspects were later connected and charged with that offense.
- Someone who identified himself as her grandson contacted a 91-year old woman and told her that he was in Mexico and had gotten mixed up in something that resulted in his arrest. He persuaded the victim to send him \$950 via Western Union at an address not in Mexico. It was when he contacted her again, requesting more money, that she became suspicious and reported it to a family member, who confirmed that her grandson was not in Mexico or in trouble.
- Burglaries were reported at residences on Long Island Drive, Edgewater and on Riverview Road.
- A 28-year old woman said she was robbed at gunpoint at 606 Riverlawn Drive, off Powers Ferry Road, after being invited to the complex by a friend. She said the friend told her to use a back entrance to the complex. It was there where she encountered two men, one of whom was

armed. She reported several items taken. The victim said she did not report the robbery for two days because her cellphone was one of the items taken.

- Officer B. Zimmerman, who joined SSPD a month ago, spotted a car in the Powers Ferry Road area that was driving erratically. He got behind the car at which time the driver of the car attempted to elude him. The driver soon wrecked on Dupree Drive and fled on foot. He was later found and arrested. The suspect is a juvenile who said a friend, who also fled after the wreck, actually stole the car earlier and asked him to drive. The car had been stolen a short time earlier from Cardigan Circle, Stonington Condos in the 7000 block of Roswell Road.

Street Crimes Unit (SCU)

- The Unit made one felony arrest, four misdemeanor arrests, six city ordinance arrests, 34 traffic stops, and issued eight citations. The Unit located four wanted persons, made one field contact, conducted seven suspicious person/vehicle stops, seized 7.6 grams of marijuana, 2.1 grams of heroin, and spent six hours assisting other agencies.
- During the week of August 7th, members of the Street Crimes Unit worked an overnight *entering auto* detail in the hotel district.
- On August 9th, the Street Crimes Unit assisted Brookhaven PD on an active home invasion incident where one suspect was barricaded. The suspect was ultimately taken into custody.

Traffic Unit

- The Unit made seven misdemeanor arrests, two DUI arrests, conducted 91 traffic stops, and issued 111 citations. The Unit spent 34 hours working traffic complaints.
- TRV 1 and 2 completed two vehicle impounds, issued seven traffic citations and handled nine crash calls. They completed 16 patrol assists, changed nine flat tires, dispensed three gallons of gasoline, and worked 75 self initiated calls, covering 744 miles.
- During the week of August 7, Officer B. Smith worked a morning traffic detail at Riverwood High School in the area of Raider Drive @ Heard's Ferry Road.
- Traffic complaints were worked on Johnson Ferry Road, GA 400, Abernathy Road, Powers Ferry Road, Riverside Drive, Edgewater Trail, Lake Forrest School zone, with a focus on school bus stop sign violations.
- On August 13th, Sergeant Levy and Officer Head were called out to investigate a traffic fatality which occurred on Dunwoody Place at Northridge Pkwy. One driver was charged with failure to obey a traffic control device and Homicide by Vehicle in the 2nd degree.

K9 Unit

- That Unit made one misdemeanor arrest, two city ordinance arrests, conducted 12 traffic stops, and issued nine citations. The Unit made three suspicious person/vehicle stops, conducted five K9 searches, and worked seven drug complaints and one knock and talk investigation. The Unit spent 36 hours assisting other units.
- During the week of August 7, Officer Hanse assisted with a hotel district *entering auto* detail. Officer Hanse deployed "Igor" on two open-air sniffs with alerts and marijuana found both times.
- Officer Stark assisted uniform patrol with the track of a suspect who ran from a stolen vehicle. The suspect was apprehended by patrol. Officer Stark and K9 "Renzo" were able to track on a pair of shoes that belonged to the suspect.
- Officers assisted the Special Investigations Unit with a drug case at apartment complex on River Exchange Drive. The K9 alert led to search warrant for an apartment resulting in the seizure of cocaine, marijuana and a vacuum sealer. One suspect was charged.

Criminal Investigations Division

- Robbery/Carjacking - Spalding Drive: The victim was carjacked at gun point by a black male suspect with a gun. The suspect was arrested by Roswell PD after a brief chase and was later identified from a photo lineup. At the request of the District Attorney, the suspect was charged with Robbery and Motor Vehicle Hijacking.
- Aggravated Battery - 8340 Roswell Road: The incident occurred in late July after a verbal argument. The suspect, Odunayo Oni, is the victim's boyfriend. The victim was struck with fists and kicked, resulting in broken facial bones and lacerations to the victim's face. Aggravated battery and battery warrants were secured for Oni's arrest.
- I-285 EB @ Ga 400 / Aggravated Assault: The victims got into a fight with the suspect at Club Taboo II, which resulted in the suspects following the victims as they left, shooting the victim's car. Video obtained does not show the suspect's face.
- Two felony arrest warrants were obtained for Rita Albritton for Financial Identity Fraud and Criminal Receipt of Goods Fraudulently Obtained. Albritton is accused of taking delivery of merchandise at the Intown Suites on Hammond Drive, with the merchandise purchased on the victim's bankcard number.
- Phone Scam: A woman received a phone call claiming that her nephew was in jail and needed money. She followed instructions and purchased \$6,000 worth of I-TUNES gift cards as payment to assist her son.
- Sexual Assault -Marsh Trail: The victim advised that she met the subject on a dating app and allowed him to pick her up at work. They spent the day shopping, then went back to his apartment to drop off 24 pairs of shoes that he had purchased. The victim went inside the apartment with him to use the restroom. When she came out of the bathroom, the suspect pushed the woman onto the couch and sexually assaulted her. After several hours at the hospital and at YWCA of Northwest Georgia (where Cobb County does their sexual assault kits), the victim decided she did not want to prosecute.
- Domestic / Suicide Threat - Greyfield Lane: The offender and his wife got into a verbal argument, and he began threatening suicide and suicide-by-cop. He pulled the fire alarm just outside his apartment door, causing an evacuation of the building. The offender then fled the complex to a hotel where he was later found, again threatening suicide. He was taken into custody by patrol, and a warrant was obtained for Transmitting False Report of a Fire. He was then taken to Northside Hospital for an evaluation.
- Several warrants obtained for a juvenile involved in stolen auto case. The juvenile was in possession of a stolen vehicle taken after the individual committed a burglary. Other stolen property was found in the vehicle. The juvenile is believed to be the Glenridge Drive serial burglar suspect. The investigation continues.

Community Affairs

- Sgt. Forrest Bohannon graduated from the Northwestern University School of Police Staff and Command (SPSC). The SPSC, hosted by Kennesaw State University, is an intensive ten-week program that prepares law enforcement managers for senior positions by uniquely combining academic principles with practical applications.
- A Citizen Firearms class was held on August 17th.
- Police Chief DeSimone attended the White House 21st Century Policing Briefing in Washington.

Volunteers:

- The Citizens on Patrol Unit worked 113 hours and conducted 19 shifts this past week.
- They conducted 14 house checks and issued 16 handicap-parking citations, covering 682 miles on patrol.
- The Citizens on Patrol continue to limit their proactive related activities due to the current events in the country.

SSFR

Operations:

- Responded to a total of 240 calls: 93 EMS calls, 13 Service Calls, 94 Good Intent Calls, 29 False Alarms
- Three TEMS members participated in an incident/arrest of a barricaded subject in the 1700 block of Briarwood Road in the City of Brookhaven.
- Crews were dispatched to reports of a power line on fire at the intersection of Windsor Parkway and High Point Road. They found a small fire on power line near a transformer. The fire was extinguished, and personnel informed the utility company that the transformer was intact as there was still power to the area.
- SSFR received a call on a technical rescue at Palisades East entrance. Grady ambulance was on scene and informed SSFR personnel that a patient fell down a cliff. Thirty minutes into the incident, looking for the patient, personnel were informed that the injured patient had been rescued by Cobb Fire personnel. However, Grady ambulance personnel who had gone looking for the patient were lost in the woods. Sandy Springs Fire and Police assisted in the search to locate the two Grady personnel. They were located and brought back to their ambulance.

Inspections:

- There were 141 inspections conducted with 42 violations cited.

Training:

- Community CPR refresher course was held for 25 Cumberland Academy staff.
- Four TEMS members attended SWAT training with North Metro SWAT.
- Three car seats were inspected with three adults trained.

Public Information:

- Deputy Chief Duke, Division Commander Willbanks, Training Officer Adams and Medical Services Officer Flaherty attended a regional meeting with MARTA and other public safety groups to plan an upcoming disaster drill in our area.
- Training Chief Adams was awarded the 2016 Georgia State Firefighters Association Training Officer of the Year, and Community Affairs Officer Ware was awarded the 2016 Georgia Chief Fire Officer at the 2016 Georgia Fire Service Conference in Augusta, GA.
- Community Affairs Officer Ware was elected to serve as the third vice president for the Georgia State Firefighters Association Board of Directors.

TRANSPORTATION

PROJECTS WITH MAJOR TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- **I-285/Riverside Drive Bridge Closed for Three Weekends in August** – Weather permitting; Georgia Department of Transportation contractors will close the Riverside Drive Bridge at I-285 for final work needed to install roundabouts at the bridge. The closures will take place beginning at 9 p.m. Friday with the bridge back open by 5 a.m. Monday.
- **Morgan Falls Road:** Paving is underway. Motorists should expect lane closures over the next 45-60 days as the paving work is conducted.
- **Lake Forrest:** Boring work, as part of geotechnical testing, will take place beginning August 29 at the Lake Forrest Dam. Lane closures will be in place 9 a.m. – 9 p.m. while the testing is underway.

The City maintains a **Road Work Advisory page** with updates on all planned lane and road closures and advisories. CIP

- T-8 Roswell Road Streetscape from Carpenter Drive to Hammond Drive: Construction is nearing completion on this project with much of the construction activities occurring at night. Final landscaping is planned for the fall.
- CC-10 Sandy Springs Circle Streetscape, Phase II: Project design and right-of-way acquisition are underway. A Public Open House was held on Wednesday, with 125 residents in attendance.
- Northridge Road Lighting: The contractor is expected to mobilize in the next few weeks with work to be completed over the next two months.
- T-34 Morgan Falls Road: Roadway repaving on Morgan Falls Road from Roswell Road to the Overlook Park has begun. The City and the Georgia Department of Transportation have completed agreements in advance of advertisement for bids of the final phase of project construction planned for late this year.
- T-43 Glenridge Drive at Roswell Road Intersection: The project preliminary plans are currently in review with GDOT.
- T-45 Windsor Parkway at Roswell Road Intersection Relocation: Roadway paving is complete with final work on the road shoulders occurring within the month.
- T-46 Carpenter Drive/Cliftwood Drive at Roswell Road Intersection Improvement: This project realigns the intersections of Cliftwood and Carpenter on Roswell Road. A construction contract is being awarded with construction expected to begin within the next two weeks. Utility relocations are underway.
- T-50 I-285 at Riverside Interchange: This Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) project installs a dual roundabout interchange and is under construction with work scheduled to be completed in August and September. Weekend bridge closures have been underway during August to conduct repairs. Installation of the new roundabout configuration is now scheduled for August 26 through 29.
- Heards Ferry at Raider Drive Intersection Improvement: This project adds turn lanes and new signalization at the intersection. Overhead utility relocations are nearing completion, and water line relocations and shoulder grading are forecasted to begin over the next few weeks.
- Powers Ferry at Heards Road Intersection Improvement: This project adds turn lanes at the intersection. A short duration water outage is planned in the immediate area next week. Lane shifts are planned for the near future to complete construction.

Transportation

- R-15137 Hammond Drive Study
 - The consultant provided potential sections along Hammond Drive with traffic analysis and modal split considerations. The consultant submitted an addendum to study focusing on the viability of mass transit. PCID, Dunwoody and COSS have agreed that the study be extended to examine the public transportation options further.
- R-15167 SR9 Median Analysis
 - Upgrade mast arms at the intersections of Dunwoody Place @ Roswell Road and Northridge Road @ Roswell Road. The project is completed.
- R-15183 Mt. Vernon @ Spalding
 - Install Supplemental Signal Head. Schedule signal head modifications are set to begin.

- T-0054 ATMS 3 - Glenridge, Hammond, PTD
 - Staff submitted right of way Certification Request Package to GDOT.

Field Services

- FY 2016 LMIG Capital Resurfacing – Additional striping work on Peachtree Dunwoody Road is being scheduled.
- FY 2016 Capital Resurfacing of Morgan Falls Road – Contractor has begun milling Morgan Falls Road in preparation for paving. This project is expected to take four weeks to complete.
- Dunwoody Club Drive from Mt Vernon Road to Happy Hollow Road (City of Dunwoody) – Resurfacing is complete, and we are awaiting completion of striping.
- Utility Permits – No Utility Permits were approved last week.

Stormwater

- There are 60 identified projects: four are under construction, two are under design, nine in contract development, one in right-of-way/easement acquisition, four in technical review, 38 in scope development, and the remaining pending final invoice or inspection.
- Eight new drainage work requests were received last week.
- Lake Forest Dam: **Geotechnical testing is expected to begin as soon as August 29. This boring work will require lane closures from 9 a.m. – 9 p.m.**
- 110 Bayvale Court –The project is under construction.
- 9395 Huntcliff Trace - Layne Inliner is scheduled to complete the project this week; weather permitting.
- 425 Kenbrook Drive - A pipe will be replaced and new catch basin tops will be installed. Chatfield Contracting is scheduled to start as early as August 22nd; weather permitting.
- 895 and 1020 Edgewater Drive – Two cross drains will be replaced along with associated facilities. Blount Construction is scheduled to start as early as August 29th; weather permitting.
- Glenforest at Brookgreen Drive – A small wall will be constructed. A schedule for the project will be coordinated with Butch Thompson.
- 6400 Riverside Drive—A pipe and catch basin will be replaced and a headwall will be installed. A schedule for the project will be coordinated with Blount Construction.
- 1644 Brandon Hall Drive – A headwall will be rebuilt. A storm pipe and catch basin will also be replaced. A schedule for the project will be coordinated with Butch Thompson.
- 6190 Riverwood Drive – A drop inlet will be replaced with a pedestal top inlet. Pricing is due August 23rd.

Impact Fees

- Work on this project is proceeding on schedule. The economic and population growth analysis is in final review. At the June 21st meeting of the Mayor and City Council, the Draft Assessment Report was presented and a resolution passed by the Council to accept the report and advertise for a public hearing at the July 19th meeting. The public hearing was conducted and the draft Capital Improvements Element has been forwarded to the Department of Community Affairs. Final recommendations will come in late summer after the review by DCA.

Building Code Standards

- At the June 21st meeting of the Mayor and City Council, a resolution was approved to advise the Department of Community Affairs of the City intent to amend the Sandy Springs Building Code to require a different type of construction standard for apartment buildings. The change would require any building over 3 stories or 100,000 square feet to be constructed of brick and masonry rather than wood. The ordinance was approved by City Council at the August 16th meeting.

Ashton Woods/Mercedes Project Review

- Staff continues to review the Land Disturbance Permit for the Ashton Woods/ Mercedes project. There are two engineers working on the south side portion of the project and a third engineer working on the road designs. Staff continues to meet with the design teams and owners in formal meetings every two weeks to try to assist with their coordination and communication issues with each other. In addition, staff met with the design team numerous times throughout the past several weeks to assist with basic design questions. At this point, several key issues

await resolution by the designers- design of retaining walls on Mercedes site, drainage problems with Mercedes that will impact the church to the south, DRI required road improvements that are not to standard, and design of the primary site entrance so that it meets standards. Due to changes partially necessitated by topography there is the need for additional traffic analysis. In spite of these challenges staff was able to issue a limited land disturbance permit for erosion and sediment control work to the Mercedes project and a full land disturbance permit to the Ashton Woods development on the north side of Abernathy Road. Work continues to review all plans to move towards full permitting.
