**City Attorney**

1. A Resolution Establishing a Municipal Court Administrative Fee to Offset Expenses Associated with Providing and Running a Municipal Court; and for Other Purposes

**City Manager John McDonough** stated staff has reexamined the cost of administering the day-to-day operations of the court, such as the court fee. City Attorney Willard is proposing a modest \$5 increase of the court fee from \$70 to \$75. There is a formula that is looked at to determine how much time and effort is put into administering the court.


**Councilman Gabriel Sterling** asked when an individual is convicted, is that person paying for the trial and conviction.


City Manager McDonough responded yes.
