 - 30 year effort led by Dr. Eva Galambos, who went on to become City's first Mayor
- City Charter governs structure and roles
- Founded on a non-traditional Public-Private Partnership (PPP) form for provision of general city services
- Focus on Customer Service First


About Sandy Springs

- Annual Operating Budget: \$103,562,695 FY- 2017

Sandy Springs At A Glance

- Demographically diverse:
 - 65% White
 - 20% Black
 - 14.2% Hispanic
- 46,955 housing units (46.2% owner occupied and 53.8% multi-family dwellings)
- Population swells to 200,000+ during daytime
 - UPS, First Data, AirWatch, Amtrak's IT Operations Center, CSM Bakery, Mercedes Benz North America Corporate, and Intercontinental Exchange (ICE), the owners of the New York Stock Exchange



Work Breakdown Structure for Field Services

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RFP#18-001 Traffic Signals Maintenance

- **Department Category: Public Works**
- Provides traffic signal maintenance and traffic sign maintenance
- Must conform to the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices, Sandy Springs and GDOT Technical Standards and Specifications
- Meet requirements of necessary equipment
- Provide on-call emergency services

RFP#18-002 Landscape Maintenance

- **Department Category: Recreation & Parks**
- Highly qualified firms must provide all personnel, equipment, materials and services necessary to provide quality landscape maintenance for the City
- Mowing, Fertilization, General Site Maintenance for 67 Parks, Greenspace and Lots
- Pruning of shrubs and trees; dead or dying hazardous branches
- Provide chemical control of insect and diseases, as needed on turf, trees and shrub beds
- Provide pesticide treatment to control yellow jackets, fire ants and other insects weekly or as directed around pavilions

RFP#18-003 Community Appearance-Workforce Elements

- **Department Category: Public Works**
- Elements include: Roadway, Right-of-Way (ROW) mowing, cleaning, maintenance, street sweeping, beautification improvement services and additional services connected with ROW maintenance
- Responsible for all equipment, vehicles, and facilities existing within the present property boundaries used within the Scope of Work
- Work within the guidelines of the City's Emergency Response Plan in the event of a natural disaster
- Provide crews for incidents, emergencies, and weather-related emergencies on a 24-hour on-call basis with 2 hour maximum response time

RFP#18-004 Stormwater Maintenance-Inspection and Repair

- **Department Category: Public Works**
- Provide stormwater repair, maintenance, and inspection services throughout the city as directed
- Work must conform to the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices and GDOT Technical Standards and Specifications
- Minimum crew of four persons with appropriate supervision and equipment for 40-hour concurrent work week schedule
 - Exception of scope requirements and recognized holidays
- Provide equipment and labor to maintain storm drain system in city in accordance with agreed upon schedules and frequencies
- Inspect storm pipes and structures that the City is responsible for maintaining
- Provide vegetation cutting and removal services up to four times per year
- Provide crews for incidents, emergencies and weather-related emergencies on 24-hour, on-call basis with 2 hour maximum response time

RFP#18-005 Street Maintenance and Repair

- **Department Category: Public Works**
- Roadway, sidewalk and Right-of-Way maintenance and repair services
 - Includes, but not limited to placing and securing of steel road plates, pothole repair, asphalt street cut restoration, curb and gutter repair/replacement, sidewalk repair/replacement/installation
 - At City direction, scheduled maintenance, upkeep and operation of city-owned equipment and facilities including, but not limited to, city-owned Salt Spreaders
- All work must conform to Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices and GDOT technical standards and specifications
- Shall provide crews for incidents, emergencies and weather-related emergencies on 24-hour on-call basis with 2 hour maximum response time
- Meet requirements of necessary equipment


Most Important Requirements

- **Accountability** – Improved measures for meeting contract requirements
- **Responsiveness** – Timely response to requests and inquiries
- **Continuity** – Continuous high-level of service
- **Capability** – Increase capability and opportunity for innovation in functional areas
- **Reduce Cost** – Utilize competition to achieve best value

Performance Price Tradeoff (PPT) Best Value Evaluation Process

- PPT permits a tradeoff between price and performance in reaching the award decision
- Best Value Selection is the lowest (reasonable and realistic) Cost/Price with highest performance confidence among acceptable proposals
