

PUBLIC SAFETY

SSPD

NORTH DISTRICT

Crime:

- The unit reported six burglaries, all taking place along the northern Peachtree Dunwoody Road corridor. Four were commercial and two were residential.
- The unit reported four *entering autos* that occurred throughout the district.
- An armed robbery/carjacking occurred in the Panhandle area. The victim was not injured. The victim's car was located later in Lithonia and its passenger detained for questioning.

Community:

- A security meeting was held with Congregation Or Hadash.
- Officers participated in the Spalding Drive Elementary Career Day, speaking to three classes of second graders about careers in law enforcement.
- SSPD participated in a meeting with representatives of the Spalding Woods Subdivision related to traffic calming measures.
- A Cub Scout Tour of SSPD headquarters was provided.

SOUTH DISTRICT

- Officers responded to a reported shooting at the Coronet Club. Two men were shot, transported to Grady Hospital with non-life threatening injuries. The area was secured and CSI, along with detectives, are investigating. The victims say they do not know the shooter.

Community:

- Officers:
 - Met with Cherokee County Sheriff's SWAT members at the Cherokee County range to test new SWAT weapons.
 - Met with members of PWF Consulting Firm at Rays on the River for a SCRAM presentation.
- Officer Begeal conducted a security survey with residents on Pine Forrest Drive and conducted a CPTED security survey at Ridgemere Place. He also conducted a senior fraud prevention class at the Cherrywood Lane Garden Club and conducted a home inspection survey on Timber Trail.
- The Sandy Springs Explorer Post 59 trained this week on the topic of crime scene investigations and CSI investigation techniques.

Street Crimes Unit (SCU)

- The unit reported one felony arrest, six misdemeanor arrests, and 11 city ordinance arrests. They conducted 112 traffic stops and issued 27 citations. There were six wanted persons located, 16 field contacts made, and 19 suspicious person/vehicle stops conducted.
- Officer Cannon arrested a subject for disorderly conduct at 5700 Roswell Road.
- Street Crimes Unit team members responded to the area of an armed robbery that occurred at the Wells Fargo ATM on New Northside Drive. SCU members assisted with a canvas of the area.
- Officer Snow located a suspicious vehicle stopped in front of a closed business at 8610 Roswell Road. He arrested a passenger who was a wanted person for "aggravated stalking" out of DeKalb County.
- Sgt. Barkley made a traffic stop in the Northwood area and found that the driver didn't have a license. The driver lied about his identity and was arrested for outstanding "battery" and "cruelty to children" warrants.

Traffic Unit

- The unit made 10 misdemeanor arrests, one city ordinance arrest, six DUI arrests, and conducted 223 traffic stops, with 254 citations issued. There was one field contact made, one suspicious person/vehicle stop conducted, and one wanted person located.
- TRV 1 and 2 impounded five vehicles, worked 10 crash calls, and conducted nine patrol assists. The unit changed five flat tires, dispensed six gallons of gasoline, and worked 91 self-initiated calls. The unit conducted four vehicle jump offs and drove more than 600 miles on patrol.
- The unit was called out to a serious injury crash involving a DUI suspect on Roswell Road at Dalrymple.
- Officer attended Sniper Supervision Training at the Roswell Public Safety Training Center.
- Members of the traffic unit conducted directed enforcement on Spalding Drive at Mabry Road, Interstate 285, Abernathy Road, Peachtree Dunwoody Road, Johnson Ferry Road, and Spalding Drive at Wycombe Road.
- Officer B. Smith attended a meeting with the Spalding Woods HOA related to traffic calming in the neighborhood.

K-9 Unit

- The unit made two felony arrests, four city ordinance arrests, and conducted 28 traffic stops, issuing 19 citations. The unit located one wanted person, conducted five k-9 searches (things), three k-9 track (people), and conducted one suspicious person/vehicle stop. The unit worked three drug complaints, executed two search warrants, and conducted five hours of surveillance.
- Officer responded to city court and conducted a K-9 sniff of a car owned by the mother of a serial juvenile burglary suspect. K-9 "Django" alerted to the vehicle, and a marijuana joint was located after a search warrant was obtained. The offender was arrested and her previous bond revoked.
- Officer conducted a traffic stop for the Special Investigations Unit. K-9 "Renzo" alerted to the gas door, and 22 grams of marijuana were located. Three people inside the vehicle were charged.

Criminal Investigations Division

- Fraud: Northland Trail - The victim learned that his information was used to open Best Buy and SAM's Club accounts. Both businesses were able to stop the fraud; however, both accounts appeared on the victim's credit report.
- Fraud: Summit Springs Drive – The victim claims that her bank account, which was recently opened with a \$25 deposit, was compromised when she lost her purse that contained a bank debit card. She told officers she had a \$4,000 check deposited, but \$31,000 was withdrawn against the account. This case is being investigated.
- 5900 block of Roswell Road: The suspect used a fake credit card to purchase \$3,000 in gift cards. The case is being investigated, and a possible suspect has been identified.
- Theft By Conversion: A subject rented more than \$8,500 worth of camera equipment from Aperturerent. The equipment was not returned by the due date, and the subject claims it was stolen in a burglary. A police report was provided; however, the report was made ten days before the suspect rented the equipment. The suspect was arrested and charged with felony theft by conversion.

Community Affairs

- Officers provided a presentation for a Daisy Scout Troop.

Volunteers:

- The Citizens on Patrol Unit worked 214 hours and conducted 30 shifts this past week. They conducted 21 house checks and issued 31 handicap-parking citations, covering 1,116 patrol miles.

- They handled 10 Private Property accidents and distributed SR13 forms.

SSFR

Operations:

- Responded to a total of 212 calls: Three fires, 79 EMS calls, 27 Service Calls, 90 Good Intent Calls, five False Alarms
- Crews responded to a North Metro SWAT call in Brookhaven related to a barricaded subject. All personnel were placed on standby upon arrival. No injuries were reported during the call.
- Crews responded to the reported call of a child locked in a car. They found the sleeping child in a running vehicle. The vehicle was opened, and the parents reported that the child was unharmed.
- Crews responded to a possible structure fire at a fast food restaurant in the 8400 block of Roswell Road. They found an electrical outlet inside the restaurant which had melted and was causing a small amount of smoke.

Inspections:

- There were 87 inspections conducted with 69 violations cited.

Training:

- Eight SSFR members attended 32 hours of live fire control classes through the Georgia Public Safety Training Center.
- SSFR members participated in Company Level Training. Topics included moving hose, forcible entry, fire ground hydraulics, and high-rise tactics.
- Active Shooter Response Training was conducted.
- Three car seat inspections were conducted with two adults trained.

Safety Education & Public Relations Events:

- One Birthday Party event was held with 57 participants.

TRANSPORTATION

PROJECTS WITH MAJOR TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- City Springs area:
 - A lane closure remains in place at the intersection of Johnson Ferry and Sandy Springs Circle for pipe installation. This work continues into March.
 - A lane of Johnson Ferry and Sandy Springs Circle, next to the Fidelity Bank will close beginning Feb. 13.
 - Dual lane closures on Sandy Springs Circle between Johnson Ferry and Mt. Vernon begins Feb 13. One northbound and one southbound lane will remain open. During the evening peak travel time, a second northbound lane will be open.
 - **Access to all of the businesses in this area will remain open during construction.**
 - A section of Hilderbrand between Bluestone and Sandy Springs Circle remains closed for the next week; however, the section of Hilderbrand from Roswell Road to Bluestone previously closed has reopened.
- Transform 285/400 Project
 - Site preparation and landscape clearing is underway for this project. Work begins on GA 400 on the southbound side from the Mt Vernon Road bridge north to Abernathy Rd. Once completed, works begins from Abernathy Road on the northbound side of GA 400 moving south to the Mt. Vernon Rd. bridge.

TSPLOST TIER ONE

- Hammond Drive, Phase 1 Efficiency Improvements:
 - T-11 Johnson Ferry/Mt. Vernon Efficiency: Design of the alternatives should commence once the change order is approved.
 - T-24 Hammond Drive Improvements from Roswell Road to Glenridge Drive: Staff is currently working on a draft scope of work for the concept/scoping study to be released during the first quarter.
- State Route 400 Trail System – Tabulation of the proposal evaluations is in progress.
- Traffic Efficiency Improvement Projects:
 - Staff has been preparing to implement the Fulton County TSPLOST projects by advertising projects for design services ahead of the collection of TSPLOST funds. Advertising now will assist in the timely delivery of projects.
- T-7104 Spalding Drive at Dalrymple Road/Trowbridge Road: A contract was awarded to KCI to create concepts and design plans to improve traffic operations at this intersection.
- T-7223 SR9 at Grogans Ferry Traffic Study: We are in the process of awarding the contract.

CIP

- T-33 CDBG Sidewalks: Roswell Road Streetscape from I-285 to Long Island: Concept plans are being developed for a Public Open House meeting which will take place March 1, 2017 beginning at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall.
- T-34 Morgan Falls Road (storm water quality features and signage): Construction is planned to begin in March.
- T-46 Carpenter Drive/Cliftwood Drive at Roswell Road Intersection Improvement: Construction continues.
- Sidewalk Program:
 - The City awarded a design services contract for two small “gap fill” sidewalk program projects as part of the FY2017 Sidewalk Program. The two sites are: Windsor Parkway west of Dalmer and Spalding Drive east of Dunwoody Road. Survey work for both projects began this week.
 - Brandon Mill from West Spalding to Marsh Creek Bridge Sidewalk: The construction contract was awarded and work is planned to begin this month for installation of sidewalk on Brandon Mill from West Spalding to the Marsh Creek bridge.
 - Dudley Lane Sidewalk: On February 7th, Council approved entering into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Atlanta to continue the sidewalk project to Chastain Park.
 - City Springs Streetscapes and Trails: The City is reviewing proposals from On Call Sidewalk Design Consultants for multi-use trails and streetscape on Johnson Ferry Road and Mt. Vernon Highway adjacent to the City Springs site.

Transportation

- R-14054 Braves Stadium: Traffic and Transportation staff continue to coordinate and prepare for SunTrust Park and Braves traffic.

- I-285 @ Riverside Interchange: The Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) is in the final stages of wrapping up construction on the dual roundabout interchange at the I-285 and Riverside Drive interchange.
- T-0044 ATMS 2 Project: Notice to proceed to the selected construction contractor was issued. The project construction duration is 18 months.
- T-7104 Spalding Dr at Dalrymple Rd-Trowbridge Road: The consultant is working on creating concepts for the intersection.
- T-7223 SR9 at Grogans Ferry Traffic Study: We are in the process of awarding the contract.
- R 15197 Last Mile Connectivity Study: This project is in the final stages, and the list of recommended projects will be used to determine which projects will be constructed with the Last Mile Connectivity TSPLOST funding.
- T-7149 Mount Paran @ Powers Ferry Rd Signal Design: Comments from the Public Open House are being reviewed and addressed. The next phase will be a recommendation of a preferred concept and advertising the project for design services.

Field Services

- FY 2015 GDOT LMIG (Peachtree Dunwoody): Punch list, clean-up and striping is underway.
- FY 2016 GDOT LMIG: Gore striping is scheduled to be completed on Hammond. A final punch list was issued this week.
- FY 2016 Capital Resurfacing of Morgan Falls Road: Striping to commence soon.
- FY 2017 Resurfacing: Street list presented to the City Council for approval at the February 7th Council meeting.
- FY 2017 GDOT LMIG: Remainder of funds for paving are \$131,796.42; 30% match will be \$39,538.93. This will be included in the FY2017 Resurfacing contract.
- Utility Permitting and Coordination
 - Six utility permits received from Jan. 31st to date.
 - Six permits issued.
 - Three permits were placed on hold. (1 ATT, 2 Comcast).
 - We have 18 active utility permits (Over 500 L.F) undergoing construction (AT&T - 8, Comcast - 10).
 - Four utility permits were closed out (AT&T 1, and Comcast 3).
 - Two water leaks were reported and forwarded to the City of Atlanta Department of Watershed Management.
 - One resident concern was addressed in the field.
 - Thirteen Lucity Ticket requests were received, and 28 requests were resolved.
- Street Lighting
 - Five Streetlight Outages were received and five outages reported to Georgia Power.
 - Two requests were made for New Streetlights and sent to Georgia Power for processing.

NATURAL RESOURCE PROTECTION

Stormwater

- There are 55 identified projects: three are under construction, one is under design, seven are in contract development, one in right-of-way/easement acquisition, four in technical review, 35 in scope development, and the remaining pending final invoice or inspection.
- Seven new drainage work requests received last week.
- 430 Old Creek Road – Storm pipes will be lined and a junction box will be constructed. Construction continues.
- 850 Habersham Waters Road – Two catch basins will be replaced. Blount began work this week.
- Crest Valley Drive at Mount Vernon Parkway, Drainage Improvement Project – Storm pipes will be replaced and catch basins will be added at the intersection. Tople started construction.
- Marsh Creek BMP Erosion Control Enhancements – A silt barrier will be installed in the junction box in front of the pond. A silt curtain will also be installed at the outfall and flocculation logs will be installed in four junction boxes along Johnson Ferry Road. Chatfield Contracting appears to have the lowest price.
- 740 Estate Way – Vegetation will be cleared out of a detention pond. Pricing is due February 14.
- Pond vegetation cutting and removal – The scope includes vegetation cutting and removal in nine City-owned detention ponds. We are recommending award to Lee Friend's Tree Service.
