PUBLIC SAFETY

SSPD

NORTH DISTRICT

Crime:

- The unit reported six entering autos, six burglaries, and one stolen vehicle this week.
- A home invasion/burglary occurred in the Branches neighborhood in which the suspect fired a gun at the homeowner. No injuries were reported. The suspect was quickly apprehended. Community:
- SSPD participated in Career Day at Sandy Springs Charter Middle School, with officers speaking to five 7th grade classes on careers in law enforcement.
- A security meeting with members of Congregation Or Hadash which included planning for future evacuation drills with staff and students.
- Police Explorer's participated in Competition in Gatlinburg, TN this weekend placing third in Active Shooter Response and second in Officer Survival.

SOUTH DISTRICT

Crime:

■ Target Security and patrol staff detained a man on shoplifting charges after his failed attempt to steal a \$600 vacuum cleaner. The arrested man was also wanted in DeKalb County on felony shoplifting charges. The Target store at the Prado has had at least two high-end vacuum cleaners taken in the past month.

Community:

- Captain Rose participated in the annual High Point Civic Association meeting.
 Street Crimes Unit (SCU)
- The unit reported one felony arrest and one city ordinance arrest, conducted 33 traffic stops, and issued seven citations. One wanted person was located, three suspicious person/vehicle stops were conducted and the unit spent 49 hours conducting surveillance. The unit seized three grams of marijuana, recovered two grams of Meth, seized 35 pills, and recovered one gun.
- Members of the Street Crimes Unit arrested Todd Vaughn who was wanted for aggravated assault and armed robbery out of Gwinnett County.
- Sgt. Levy attempted a traffic stop on a vehicle driving in the emergency lane of GA 400 north when the vehicle exited onto Dunwoody Place and fled. The vehicle was later located abandoned on Roberts Drive having struck a Dunwoody Hills / Dunwoody Lakes sign. Methamphetamines, a gun, pills and an electronic scale were located in vehicle.

Traffic Unit

- The unit made four misdemeanor arrests, three DUI arrests, and 172 traffic stops, issuing 199 citations. The unit spent just under six hours working traffic complaints and more than 11 hours assisting other units.
- TRV 1 and 2 impounded six vehicles, worked 12 crash calls, and conducted 13 patrol assists. The unit changed 11 flat tires, dispensed 10 gallons of gasoline, and worked 96 self-initiated/dispatched calls, covering 900 miles on patrol.
- Traffic enforcement was conducted on GA 400, I-285, Mountain Brook Way, Abernathy Road, Wright Road, Edgewater Drive at Riverside, Colquitt Road at Pitts Road, Johnson Ferry Road, Trowbridge at Spalding Drive, and Peachtree Dunwoody Road.

K-9 Unit

■ The unit made one city ordinance arrest, conducted 17 traffic stops, and issued nine citation. The unit conducted 75 K-9 searches (things), worked five drug complaints, and made one suspicious person stop. More than 50 pounds of marijuana was seized on a detail.

- Officer Hanse assisted the Uniform Patrol Division with the investigation of a Feb. 6, 2017 shooting in the 5200 block of Roswell Road. His K-9 partner "Igor" was deployed for an article search and open air sniff of a vehicle.
- Officer Stark assisted the John's Creek Police Department with a school search.
- Officer Stark stopped a vehicle for a lane violation on I-285. The smell of marijuana was coming out of the vehicle, and a small amount of the drug was located with the driver charged with disorderly conduct (drugs).
- Officer Reynnells assisted the Uniform Patrol Division with the search of a suspect who fled a scene on Granite Ridge Drive. The suspect was not located, but it was determined that he had committed a burglary on Calaveras Drive.
- Officer Reynnells assisted the United States Postal Service with K-9 sniffs of more than 40 packages with more than 46 pounds of marijuana seized.

Criminal Investigations Division

- Fraud: The victim reported that her mail was stolen and her information was used to open accounts in her name. She has already contacted the Postal Inspector about the theft of her mail, and SSPD referred her to her an outside agency because the Fraud was being committed in another jurisdiction.
- Theft-by-Deception: A warrant issued for Aaron Porter for one count of Misdemeanor Theft by Deception. Mr. Porter is believed to have switched out Go Pro Cameras for cheap imitation ones and then returning the fake cameras to Target for a full refund. Mr. Porter and two others are suspected in approximately 14 cases at different Target locations.
- Taboo II Murder (August 4 2014): Suspects David Wilson and Arquavius Strickland entered guilty pleas. David Wilson was sentenced to serve 40 years in prison and Arquavius Strickland was sentenced to serve 35 years. They are not eligible for any early release programs.
- Armed Robbery-200 block of Northwood Drive (October 10th 2016): Phone records for one of the three suspects came back and is inconclusive for the SSPD case. The three suspects in this case are in the Cobb County Jail for other metro area armed robberies and a murder.
- Motorcycle theft from 1100 block of Hammond Drive: The owner of the motorcycle identified the suspect as the son of the person the victim had loaned the vehicle to. A warrant for the suspect was obtained for Burglary (entering the secured parking garage) and *theft by taking*. Community Affairs
- Officers conducted a Cub Scout precinct tour and participated in a round table discussion with high school students from Mount Vernon Presbyterian School.
 Volunteers:
- The Citizens on Patrol Unit worked 232 hours and conducted 31 shifts this past week. They conducted 31 house checks and issued 28 handicap-parking citations, covering 1,256 miles on patrol.
- They handled five Private Property accidents and distributed SR13 forms.

SSFR

Operations:

- Responded to a total of 230 calls: Four fires, 96 EMS calls, 19 Service Calls, 82 Good Intent Calls, 25 False Alarms
- Annual ladder testing for both aerial and ground ladders was conducted.
- Crews responded to smoke detector activation in the 1000 block of Huntcliff Village Court. The caller advised that she had water coming through the smoke detectors in her apartment. Fire personnel

removed two smoke detectors because they were sounding and tried to make contact with the unit one floor above. Crewmembers found the main water valve for the building and shut the water off. It was determined that the water heater in the upstairs unit had malfunctioned.

- Crews responded to a call with AMR (American Medical Response) in the 200 block of Jefferson Drive where a patient was complaining of chest pain. While moving the patent, he became unconscious and pulseless, with V-Fib on the monitor. The patient was bagged and shocked, converting into a stronger pulse, regaining respirations. The patient was eventually transported with improving conditions to the hospital.
- Crews responded to a fire alarm in the 2000 building of an apartment complex in the 5500 block of Glenridge Drive. The crew was advised that a broken sprinkler pipe was pouring water into the units. Crews found a large amount of water on all levels. A contractor had stepped on the sprinkler water line. The fire pump activated when the water line was broken. The line was turned off prior to SSFR's arrival. Georgia Power checked the meters providing advisement on restoration of service. At least 20 units were damaged.

PROJECTS WITH MAJOR TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Water Outage Alert Saturday, Feb 18 beginning at 7 a.m.: Homes in the Glenridge Drive, Glenlake Parkway and Abernathy Rd area will experience water outages as the City of Atlanta completes a water valve repair. As part of this work, there will be a lane closure on the SB lane of Glenridge Drive, just north of the intersection with Abernathy Rd beginning Friday, Feb 17 at 9 am 4 pm and on Saturday from 9 am until the repair is completed (approximately 7 p.m.)
- Lane Closure: Intersection of Crest Valley Dr and Mt Vernon Parkway as a storm drain is replaced. Closure in effect Wed., Feb 22 Fri. Feb 24 from 9 a 4 p each day.
- Lane Closure: Intersection of Johnson Ferry and Sandy Springs Circle and in lane closest to Fidelity Bank for pipe installation.
