

Week in Review: Week Ending 3-4-2017

PUBLIC SAFETY

SSPD

NORTH DISTRICT

Crime:

- The unit reported 10 *entering autos*, two burglaries, and no motor vehicle thefts this week.
- An unidentified white male passed a note, but did not display a weapon, robbing the SunTrust Bank on Holcomb Bridge Road. CID is investigating.

Community:

- SSPD participated in the North Springs High School College and Career Expo.

SOUTH DISTRICT

Crime:

- Several alcohol compliance checks were conducted in the district. Thirteen establishments were checked with seven cases made related to criminal and code-compliance violations. Citations were issued at the Shell Gas Station (5700 Roswell Road), Royal Package Store (5325 Roswell Road), Citi Wine and Spirits (Roswell Road), the BP Gas Station (Hammond Drive), and the Shell Gas Station (Cliftwood and Roswell). Several code violations were also issued.

Community:

- Officer Burell represented SSPD South District for the annual Polar Plunge at Lake Altoona.

Street Crimes Unit (SCU)

- The unit reported one felony arrest, two misdemeanor arrests, six city ordinance arrests, and conducted 37 traffic stops, issuing 12 citations. There was one wanted person located, and the unit made four field contacts, four suspicious person/vehicle stops, and issued one Search Warrant. The unit seized 53 grams of marijuana, .02 grams of cocaine, recovered two stolen vehicles, and spent 12 hours assisting other units.
 - Officer stopped a vehicle in the Dunwoody Place area for a tag light violation. The driver was in possession of marijuana and drug paraphernalia and was charged accordingly.
 - Officer made a traffic stop on Lake Forrest Drive and arrested the three occupants for disorderly conduct / drugs. One of the suspects also had an outstanding felony warrant.
- Officer located two stolen vehicles at the Wesley St. James Apartments.
- Officer attended a High Risk Warrant Class at the Georgia Public Safety Training Center.
- Members of the Street Crimes Unit attended QRF (Quick Response Force) training.

Traffic Unit

- The unit made eight misdemeanor arrests, four DUI arrests, and conducted 162 traffic stops, issuing 202 citations. The unit located one wanted person, conducted two suspicious person/vehicle stops, and spent more than 15 hours working traffic complaints.
- TRV 1 and 2 conducted three vehicle impounds, worked 18 crash calls, and conducted 22 patrol assists. The unit changed eight flat tires, dispensed six gallons of gasoline, and worked 66 self-initiated/dispatched calls. The unit conducted five vehicle jump offs and covered 594 miles on patrol.
- Speeding enforcement was conducted on Abernathy Road, GA 400, and I-285.
- Members of the traffic unit monitored the construction zone at Sandy Springs Circle near Johnson Ferry Road during morning, lunchtime, and afternoon peak hours.
- Officers assisted Chatcomm with an active shooter evacuation drill.
- Officers attended QRF (Quick Response Force) training.

K-9 Unit

- The unit made three felony arrests, one misdemeanor arrest, one city ordinance arrest, and conducted 14 traffic stops, issuing 11 citations. There were five K-9 search (things), one suspicious person/vehicle stop, and the unit worked three drug complaints. One search warrant was issued. The unit seized one gram of marijuana and 2.2 grams of heroin.
- During a traffic stop, Officer smelled the odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. One subject was found to be in possession of marijuana and was arrested for disorderly conduct (drugs).
- Sgt. assisted the Special Investigations Unit with a narcotics investigation in the 4600 block of Roswell Road. A search warrant was obtained and one gun was located. Two felony arrests were made.
- The K-9 Unit attended QRF (Quick Response Force) training.

Criminal Investigations Division

- Fraud - High Point Road: The victim was contacted by phone and convinced that a family member was in trouble and needed financial assistance. The victim then went to a Dunwoody Walmart and wired money to New York. The investigation continues.
- Commercial Burglary - Experimac: SSPD met with the owner and conducted a canvass of area. The suspects wanted are part of a federal investigation and are hitting stores all over the southeast. Video footage was released to the news media.
- Burglary - Winding River Drive: Arrest warrants were secured for Yolanda Downs for Burglary in the First Degree and felony computer trespassing. Downs is the victim's ex-girlfriend and was arrested for taking his laptop and hacking into his Google accounts, changing his passwords and adding her phone number to the profile.
- After a week-long trial, Patricko Davis was convicted of Aggravated Assault/Felony Murder. He received a sentence of life in prison. Davis was convicted in the shooting death of an Art Institute of Atlanta student three years ago.
- A warrant for Forgery in the Fourth Degree was obtained for a male individual suspected of passing a counterfeit American Express Travelers Check for \$100 U.S. dollars. The suspect was caught on camera as well as his car tag which were used to identify the man.
- SIU is investigating a drug overdose death of a 23-year-old Hispanic male in an apartment on Hammond Drive. Several large bags of what appeared to be Heroin were recovered at the site.

Community Affairs

- Citizen Police Academy, Class 25 is now underway.

Volunteers:

- The Citizens on Patrol Unit worked 189 hours and conducted 26 shifts this past week. They conducted 22 house checks and issued 20 handicap-parking citations, covering 1,164 patrol miles.
- They handled eight Private Property accidents and distributed SR13 forms.

SSFR

Operations:

- Responded to a total of 211 calls: Three fires, 76 EMS calls, 18 Service Calls, 81 Good Intent Calls, 24 False Alarms

- Crews responded to a one-car accident at the intersection of Mount Vernon Highway and Powers Ferry Road. A leaking gas tank prompted Sandy Springs Police to request SSFR assistance.
- Crews responded to a reported vehicle fire in the parking garage adjacent to the emergency entrance at Northside Hospital. The owner stated she parked the car, noticed the odor of smoke as she exited the vehicle and saw smoke coming from under hood. There was extensive fire damage to the vehicle from the windshield to the front of the car. The motor and all of the components within the engine compartment were destroyed. Vehicles on each side of the fire did not appear to have suffered any damage from fire exposure.
- Crews responded to power lines down with a tree burning in the 1500 block of Spalding Drive. There was also a small fire on the ground from burning embers that fell from the tree. Crews put out the small fire with a water can. Georgia Power was also called to the scene related to the down lines.

Inspections:

- There were 85 inspections conducted with 134 violations cited.

Training:

- There were 70 hours of company level training conducted including hose deployment, driver training, water supply, and fire attack.
- Training division presented “Technical Rescue Core Skills” as part of a four-day certificate class.

Safety Education & Public Relations Events:

- SSFR participated in the Career Day event at North Springs Charter High School with 830 participants.
- Two car seat inspections were conducted with two adults trained.

Public Information:

- Chief Sanders the SSFR Command staff attended the Lieutenant Pinning Ceremony for Brandon Mann.

TRANSPORTATION

PROJECTS WITH MAJOR TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lane closures continue between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. at the intersection of Crest Valley Dr. and Mt Vernon Parkway.
- The lanes closest to City Springs on Johnson Ferry Road and Sandy Springs Circle remain closed as construction continues.

- Hammond Drive, Phase 1 Efficiency Improvements:
 - T-11 Johnson Ferry/Mt. Vernon Efficiency: Design of the alternatives should commence once the change order is approved.
 - T-24 Hammond Drive Improvements from Roswell Road to Glenridge Drive: Staff is working on a draft scope of work for the concept/scoping study.
- State Route 400 Trail System: The consultant has been selected.

Traffic Efficiency Improvement Projects:

- Fulton County TSPLOST: Advertising projects for design services has begun.

- T-7104 Spalding Dr at Dalrymple Rd-Trowbridge Rd: Subsurface utility locating will be taking place over the next couple of weeks.
- T-7223 SR9 at Grogans Ferry Rd: A contract was awarded to Columbia Engineering to create concepts and design plans to improve traffic operations and safety at the intersection by installing a new traffic signal.
- T-7149 Mount Paran Rd @ Powers Ferry Rd Signal Design: A recommendation of a preferred concept will be presented to the City Council on March 21, 2017.

CIP

- T-33 CDBG Sidewalks: Roswell Road Streetscape from I-285 to Long Island: Concept plans were presented at a Public Open House meeting on March 1, 2017.
- T-34 Morgan Falls Road: Construction is planned to begin in March.
- T-43 Glenridge Drive at Roswell Road Intersection: Right of way efforts will begin next month.
- T-46 Carpenter Drive/Cliftwood Drive at Roswell Road Intersection Improvement: Construction continues.
- T-62 City Springs Streetscapes and Trails: Design is beginning for three multi-use trails and streetscapes near City Springs: Sandy Springs Circle from Mt. Vernon Highway to Johnson Ferry Road (west side); Johnson Ferry Road from Sandy Springs Circle to Roswell Road (north side); and a trail between Mt. Vernon Highway and Hilderbrand adjacent to the City Springs site.
- Sidewalk Program:
 - Brandon Mill from West Spalding to Marsh Creek Bridge Sidewalk: The construction contract was awarded and work is planned to begin this month for installation of sidewalk on Brandon Mill from West Spalding to the Marsh Creek bridge.
 - Glenridge Drive at Northland Drive: Design is nearly complete for this sidewalk project with construction bidding planned for later this year.

Transportation

- R-14054 Braves Stadium: Traffic and Transportation Staff are continuing to coordinate and prepare for SunTrust Park and Braves traffic.
- I-285 @ Riverside Interchange: The Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) is in the final stages of wrapping up construction on the dual roundabout interchange at the I-285 and Riverside Drive interchange.
- T-0044 ATMS 2 Project: Notice to proceed to the selected construction contractor was recently issued. The project construction duration is 18 months.
- T-0054 ATMS 3 Project: The Invitation to Bid (ITB) on construction of the projects was advertised on February 15, 2017, and bids are due on March 29, 2017.
- R 15197 Last Mile Connectivity Study: This project is in the final stages, and the list of recommended projects will be used to determine which projects will be constructed with the Last Mile Connectivity TSPLOST funding. A presentation will be made to City Council on March 7, 2017.

Field Services

- FY 2016 Capital Resurfacing of Morgan Falls Road: Striping began February 26.
- FY 2017 Resurfacing: Project is being advertised.
- ROW Maintenance – Sidewalk Repairs: Work began February 27, 2017.
- Utility Permitting and Coordination
 - Fifteen utility permits received from Feb. 14, 2017 to date.
 - Nine permits were issued.
 - Two Pre-Construction meetings were held.

- We currently have 29 active utility permits (Over 500 L.F) undergoing construction (Google - 0, AT&T - 8, Comcast – 21, Level3 - 0).
- Three utility permits were closed out.
- Two water leaks were received and reported to City of Atlanta Department of Watershed Management.
- One stop work order was issued (AT&T) due to non-compliance with City of Sandy Springs Utility Accommodation Guidelines.
- Three resident concerns were addressed in the field by staff pertaining to restorations, water line damages, gas line damages, and general questions about the utility work. Five residential (included one stated above) were resolved.
- Seven Lucity ticket requests received and 16 ticket requests were resolved.
- Street Lighting
 - Three Streetlight Outages were received.
 - Three Streetlight Outages were reported to Georgia Power.
 - Two reported GPC lights were repaired.

- There are 52 identified projects: three are under construction, one is under design, six are in contract development, one in right-of-way/easement acquisition, two in technical review, 37 in scope development, and the remaining pending final invoice or inspection.
- One new drainage work request was received last week.
- 430 Old Creek Road – Construction continues.
- Crest Valley Drive at Mount Vernon Parkway, **Lane closures** for a storm pipe replacement will continue at the Crest Valley Drive and Mount Vernon Parkway intersection at least through next week.
- 585 Trowbrook Road – Construction continues.
- Marsh Creek BMP Erosion Control Enhancements – Chatfield Contracting appears to have the lowest price. We will coordinate a schedule with the contractor after the purchase order is issued.

- 740 Estate Way – Blount Construction appeared to have the lowest price. We will coordinate a schedule with the contractor after the purchase order is issued.
- 5201 Powers Ferry Road – The project involves the survey, field investigation, data collection and design of storm sewer system improvements as well as a water quality treatment facility. We are reviewing quotes.
- 465 Hammond Drive – The project includes construction of drainage structures, storm pipe and lining an existing storm pipe. Bids are due March 23, 2017.
- Pond vegetation cutting and removal – The scope includes vegetation cutting and removal in nine City-owned detention ponds. The low bidder was unresponsive. We will review the next lowest bid.
