

Week in Review: Week Ending 10-6-2017

## PUBLIC SAFETY

### SSPD

North District

Crime:

The unit reported:

- Five *entering autos* and two burglaries this week.
  - License plates were taken from two of the *entering autos* cases.
- Two robberies were reported. In one case, the two suspects were armed, grabbing a cellphone.
- Witnesses reported hearing shots fired from the rear area of a hotel after a white minivan, driven by an older white male and white female passenger, drove off at a high rate of speed chased by a black male on foot. No known victim(s), injuries or shell casings were located. The following day, officers returned to the location after the minivan was reported back on scene. The owner/driver was located and arrested for Reckless Driving and Disorderly Conduct. It was determined that he was not the person suspected of shooting the previous evening.

Community

- Officers attended a fire drill at UPS, assisting with vehicle traffic control and answering questions regarding police response to fire alarms and active shooter incidents.
- SSPD taught a Civilian Response to Active Shooter Events training class at VanCo Payments.
- Woodland Elementary has been very proactive in collaborating with the SSPD. Their "High Five Fridays" is a day where members of the community and SSPD community officers meet at the school and greet the students as they come in to school on Fridays.
- Community officers took part in the Georgia Statewide Human Trafficking detail, visiting hotels throughout the North District reminding staff on the posted signage requirements for the hotels.

South District

Crime:

- An *entering auto* was reported at Hammond Park with a backpack containing a laptop computer taken. In a separate incident in the 5600 block of Roswell Road, a witness saw a black male break the window of a Nissan Pathfinder, removing a bag containing a MacBook. The suspect fled the scene in an unknown sedan.
- The South District had a rash of landscaping equipment stolen from four different landscaping trucks during one day inside of several different residential neighborhoods. A witness observed a Silver Toyota Corolla leave the area being driven by a black male with a beard and a ball cap.
- The apartment door of a residence in the 5600 block of Roswell Road was kicked in, and two beds, a TV, and a Comcast Cable box were taken from the apartment.
- A burglary occurred on Green Hill Road. The basement window was broken out, but nothing was missing from the home.
- A robbery by snatch occurred at Northside Hospital when a male suspect snatched medication out of the hand of an elderly victim as she left the pharmacy. Security personnel gave chase and were able to detain the suspect until SSPD arrived on scene. The suspect was taken to jail.
- Officers received a welfare check call on I-285 eastbound at Riverside Drive of on a male appearing to be unconscious inside a pickup truck. The subject was found to be deceased from an apparent self-inflicted gunshot wound.
- One person was killed in an accident on I-285 eastbound at Riverside Drive. A Honda Accord was traveling in the far right lane at a slow rate of speed with the emergency flashers activated,

when it was rear-ended and then forced into another lane. The vehicle was then struck by a tractor-trailer. It is unknown if the vehicle was having mechanical issues.

- South District Officers arrested two males who were trespassing at a construction site in the 6100 block of Roswell Road. The suspects claimed they were in the area to take photos. They were charged with loitering and prowling.

#### Street Crimes Unit (SCU)

- The unit reported 41 traffic stops, issued 34 citations, and located five wanted persons. The unit made five field contacts, six suspicious person/vehicle stops, worked one drug complaint, and spent 17 hours on surveillance. The unit made two knock and talk investigations and spent 78 hours assisting other units and 2.5 hours assisting other agencies.

#### Traffic Unit

- The unit made four misdemeanor arrests, two DUI arrests, 38 traffic stops, and issued 53 citations. The unit spent 75 hours working traffic complaints, worked 54 active cases, spent 12.5 hours assisting other units, two hours assisting other agencies, and one call out.
- The Traffic Unit Assisted SSFR with a funeral detail.

#### K-9 and Special Investigations Unit (SIU)

- The unit made two felony arrests, five misdemeanor arrests, and one city ordinance arrest. The unit made 20 traffic stops, issued 17 citations, one field contact, and conducted seven suspicious person/vehicle stops. The K-9 conducted nine searches (people/things). The unit worked 17 drug complaints, conducted seven knock and talk investigations, spent 22 hours assisting other units, 10 hours assisting other agencies, and seized 2.48 pounds of marijuana.
- The unit checked 10 hotels as part of a Hotel/Motel detail.

#### Criminal Investigations Division and Special Investigations (SIU)

- Burglary, 5300 block of Roswell Rd.: A "Ring" camera captured an unknown white male attempt to enter the residence through the front door. The victim caught the offender, who forced his way through front window. Blood was collected from the scene and submitted to the GBI. The victim has been uncooperative during interviews following the incident.
- Aggravated Stalking, 1000 block of Johnson Ferry Rd.: Offender is a previous patient from Northside Behavioral Health that SSPD obtained warrants on for Stalking, while Victim obtained a permanent TPO. Offender was able to locate victim's personal email after he was served with the TPO, and sent a lengthy email violating the TPO. Warrants have been obtained for Aggravated Stalking and have been turned over to Street Crimes to locate offender.
- Credit Card Fraud: Victim stated that his card was fraudulently used while the card was in his possession. Video was obtained from the locations that had video and they were furnished to the bank. The bank believed that the victim was actually the suspect and was not actually a victim. The video was inconclusive and the bank refunded the victim his money. The case is inactive.
- Embezzlement, 400 block Morgan Falls Rd., Adair Apts: The victim reported that the company believed an employee was embezzling money. There was documentation of the suspect moving money around internally, but nothing showing where the money was going after it was moved around. It was unknown if the money was being withdrawn. A court order for the suspect's bank account was denied. A further audit is being requested to determine if the money actually left the business account or was hidden internally.

- Burglary Attempt, 5800 block of Pine Brook Rd.: The homeowner heard his dogs barking and got up to investigate. The homeowner found a small shovel perched up against his house next to a sliding glass door and later found his car keys lying in the grass. Nothing was determined taken.
- Entering Auto, Manorwood Ct.: The victim's vehicle was entered by a black male with light complexion who had a full beard. The male stole a small amount of cash from the victim's car. The suspect then entered the victim's porch and stole a pair of Adidas sandals. The homeowner had a doorbell video system, which captured the incident. The male fled on foot. A BOLO (Be on the Lookout) was created.
- Identity Fraud, Carriage Dr.: The elderly victim checked her credit and found that unknown suspects used her identity to open a credit card account with Synchrony Bank. The suspect then spent \$6,500 at a spa called Slim Image. During the course of the investigation, the detective confirmed through Synchrony Bank that the actual fraud occurred in Missouri. The detective informed the victim and forwarded the case to the appropriate jurisdiction in Missouri. The case has been unfounded in our jurisdiction.

#### Community Affairs

- Citizen's Police Academy held a class related to the 911 Center.
- The Chief of Police met with The Davis Academy Head of Security and Bailey Rogers, the North Fulton Community Prosecutor.

#### Volunteers

- The Citizens on Patrol Unit worked 132 hours and conducted 16 shifts this past week. They conducted seven house checks and issued 14 handicap-parking citations, covering 807 patrol miles.
- They handled nine Private Property accidents and distributed SR13 forms.

Total alarms: 99, **False alarms: 95**, Calls for Service (CFS): 2008, Citizen Initiated CFS: 827, Officer Initiated CFS: 1181, Accidents: 159

#### SSFR

##### Operations:

- Responded to a total of 206 calls: One fire, 85 EMS calls, 23 Service Calls, 75 Good Intent Calls, 12 False Alarms
- Units responded to an apartment complex structure fire on Cedar Run. Personnel observed heavy flames and raised the ladder pipe to knock down the fire. Once all hot spots were extinguished, the crew began overhaul. Fire Corps members arrived to assist with rehab.

##### Inspections:

- There were 70 inspections conducted with 25 violations cited.

##### Training:

- Fire crews participated in the following training exercises: MARTA rail car fire procedures, Fire Apparatus Operator Training, Combat Challenge PT course, Municipal Water Supply, Firefighter Bailout Training

##### Safety Education & Public Relations Events:

- SSFR oversaw eight Public Education events with 4,715 participants:

- Fire Corp members volunteered 412 hours of service in September. Activities include:

  - Participation in EMR training and manning the Fire Rescue booth at the Sandy Springs Festival

**TRANSPORTATION**

**PROJECTS WITH MAJOR TRAFFIC IMPACTS**

Construction crews will begin final paving for the roadways surrounding City Springs the week of October 16. Most of the work will be conducted at night. Roadways will be milled first – removing the surface level of the roadway by grinding the top layer. Following, a new layer of pavement is put in place.

Crews will work along the following sequence for milling:

- Mt Vernon Hwy – from Roswell Road to West Mt Vernon (near the church)
- Sandy Springs Circle – from Johnson Ferry to Mt. Vernon Highway and Sandy Springs Circle/Johnson Ferry Intersection
- Johnson Ferry Rd – from Sandy Springs Circle to Roswell Road

For paving, the tentative sequence will be:

- Mt Vernon
- Johnson Ferry
- Sandy Springs Circle

Hilderbrand at Bluestone Road will be milled and paved during daytime hours to best accommodate residents in that area.

The City maintains a **Road Work Advisory page** with updates on all planned lane and road closures and advisories. You can receive weekly traffic updates and emergency traffic alerts via email and/or text by signing up for **Sandy Springs Alerts**.

**TSPLOST TIER ONE TRAFFIC EFFICIENCY IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS:**

TSPLOST SIDEWALKS PROGRAM: *Design and survey work have begun for the following projects:*

- Johnson Ferry Road – Harelston to 425 Johnson Ferry
- Johnson Ferry Road/Kayron Drive – 471 Johnson Ferry to Glenridge
- Johnson Ferry Road at Glenridge connector (at Wells Fargo site)
- Windsor Parkway between Peachtree Dunwoody and City limit. This project provides sidewalk connections on the south side of Windsor Parkway to complete the sidewalk system along this roadway. Concept plans are in development.

- Northwood – Kingsport to Roswell Road. This project will provide sidewalk connections and pedestrian scale lighting along the south side of Northwood from Kingsport to existing sidewalk near Roswell Road. Right-of-way acquisitions efforts should begin in the next few weeks.
- Spalding Drive – Spalding Lake Court to Publix Shopping Center
- Brandon Mill Road – Marsh Creek to Lost Forest Drive. Design and survey work are planned to begin next month for this sidewalk project.
- Gap Fill Projects: Design is complete for two small “gap fill” sidewalk program projects as a part of the FY2017 Sidewalk Program - Windsor Parkway west of Dalmer and Spalding Drive east of Dunwoody Road. Construction is planned for later this year for both projects.

#### Traffic Efficiency Improvement Projects:

- T-7178/TS116 Dunwoody Club Drive at Jett Ferry Road: A kick-off meeting with the selected consultant was held this week. New stops signs are being deployed in November that will have blinking LED lights to increase the visibility of the signs to motorists and improve safety operations.
- T-7232/TS111 Spalding Drive at Pitts Road: This project will create concepts and design plans to improve traffic operations at this intersection. A kick-off meeting with the selected consultant is scheduled for October 10, 2017.
- T-7126/TS106 Riverview Drive at Northside Drive: This project will create concepts and design plans to improve traffic operations at this intersection. A kick-off meeting with the selected consultant was held this week.
- T-7149/TS110 Mount Paran Road at Powers Ferry Road: This project will construct a signal lane roundabout at the intersection of Mount Paran Road and Powers Ferry Road. The project is in the design phase.
- T-7223/TS105 SR 9 at Grogans Ferry Road: This project will construct a traffic signal at Roswell Road and Grogans Ferry Road and will install a median along Roswell Road in the vicinity of Grogans Ferry Road to improve safety operations. **A design concept for this will be presented at a public information open house (PIOH) on October 26, 2017.**

#### CIP

- CC-10 Sandy Springs Circle Streetscape, Phase II: Final design development, utility coordination and relocation planning and right-of-way acquisition efforts are underway for streetscape and roadway enhancement on Sandy Springs Circle from Mt. Vernon Road to Hammond Drive. A multi-purpose trail is also planned. Site investigations have begun with utility relocations projected for winter 2017. Project construction estimated for summer 2018.
- T-33 CDBG Sidewalks Roswell Road Streetscape from I-285 to Long Island: Design work to develop Overlay District-compliant streetscape on the west side of Roswell Road from I-285 to Long Island Drive continues. Right-of-way acquisition and utility coordination activities are underway.
- T-34 Morgan Falls Road: The City will rebid the construction contract for this project.
- T-43 Glenridge Drive at Roswell Road Intersection: Project environmental coordination, utility coordination and design work continue. Right-of-way acquisition coordination with property owners is underway.
- T-58 Connector Street from Boylston to Roswell Road (Denmark Drive): Water line installation on Roswell Road is in progress with initial roadway paving scheduled to take place next week.
- T-62 City Springs Streetscapes and Trails: Design work is underway for three multi-use trails and streetscape near the City Springs site. Construction is planned for 2018.

- Sandy Springs Circle from Mt. Vernon Highway to Johnson Ferry Road (west side) provides a multi-use side path, lighting and landscaping from Mt. Vernon Highway to the Fire Station.
- Johnson Ferry Road from Sandy Springs Circle to Roswell Road (north side) provides a multi-use side path, landscaping and lighting on Johnson Ferry across the street from the new Performing Arts Center and City Springs.
- Mt. Vernon Highway and Hilderbrand adjacent to City Springs' site provides a connecting multi-use trail between Mt. Vernon Highway and Hilderbrand immediately adjacent to the Georgia Power Company substation.
- Mabry Road Drainage Project: Construction is planned to begin later this year.
- Sidewalk Program:
  - Glenridge Drive at Northland Drive: Construction plans are being prepared for bidding.
  - Dudley Lane Sidewalk: Design is complete. Final right-of-way acquisition and utility coordination are underway.

#### Transportation

- T-0044 ATMS 2 Project  
Construction crews will conduct rolling lane closures (minimal impact to traffic) over the next few weeks to install devices in the road.
- T-7161 Mount Vernon Highway at Long Island Drive: Construction is complete.

#### Field Services

- FY 2017 Resurfacing FY 2017 GDOT LMIG
  - Final sharrows (share the road) are being installed.
- FY16 Bridge Maintenance
  - Bid package is in development for repair of Windsor Parkway Bridge over Nancy Creek.
- Mowing
  - Pro Cutter mowing crews worked on GA 400 this week.
- Litter Pickup
  - Continued work and review of litter pickup on I-285 & GA 400.
- Utility Permitting and Coordination
  - Six utility permits received from Sept 22 – 29, 2017.
  - 280 Utility permits are eligible to be activated that have not yet started.
  - 303 Utility permits have expired, but will be re-submitted for work.
  - 14 permits were issued.
  - Two Pre-Construction meeting were held.
  - Two permits were placed on hold. (0 ATT, 1 Comcast, 1 AGL, 0 Other).
  - There are nine active utility permits (Over 500 L.F) undergoing construction; 50 permits are in the process of being closed upon completion of restoration (2 AGL, 48 Comcast, 0 AT&T).
  - Four (Pending) utility permits closed out.
  - Ten water leaks were reported to Sandy Springs and then reported to City of Atlanta Department of Watershed Mgmt.
  - Four resident concerns were addressed in the field by staff pertaining to restorations, water line damages, gas line damages, and general questions about the utility work. Two concerns are in the process of being resolved.
- 37 Service Ticket requests were received and four Service Ticket requests were resolved.
- There are 39 active City of Atlanta (COA) water leaks.
  - Six New
  - 12 Open COA restorations

- Street Lighting
  - 5 Streetlight Outages were received.
  - 7 Streetlight Outages were reported to Georgia Power (GPC).
  - 30 Street Light Outages were reported to Sandy Springs.
  - 1 Request for New Streetlights was sent out for petition signatures.
  - 12 reported GPC lights were repaired; 24 reported City lights were repaired.

#### After Hours Calls / Emergencies

- Field Services:
  - One After Hours Call – Tree Down/Powers Lines down on Mt. Paran. Determined to be on private property.
- Traffic Services:
  - 9/27/17 – Staff received a report of a signal malfunction at Roswell Road and Sandy Springs Circle. GTG responded and reset the signal.
  - 9/27/17 – Staff received a report of a signal in flash at Mt. Vernon Hwy. and Glenridge Drive. GTG responded and found the signal operating properly.
  - 9/28/17 – Staff received a report of a signal not cycling at Roswell Road and Dunwoody Place. GTG responded and found the signal operating properly.

## NATURAL RESOURCE PROTECTION

### Stormwater

- There are 69 identified projects: two are under construction, three are under design, three in contract development, one in right-of-way/easement acquisition, ten in technical review, 49 in scope development, and the remaining pending final invoice or inspection.
- One new drainage work request was received last week.
- 1107 Crest Valley Drive – A culvert and catch basin will be replaced. The consultant is revising the design concept.
- 5730 Pinebrook Road – A stream bank has significantly eroded near a residence. Stormwater modeling is complete with the results under review.
- 7185 Hunters Branch Drive – A catch basin is being re-built. The contract is being reviewed.
- Northland/Windsor Parkway – The project consists of replacing storm pipe and structures in the right-of-way at the Northland/Windsor Parkway intersection. The contract is being reviewed.
- 1650 Brandon Hall Drive – A pipe will be lined. A schedule is being coordinated with the contractor.
- 7000 Central Parkway – A manhole will be lined. Construction continues.
- 7455 Talbot Colony – A portion of a storm pipe is being replaced while another portion is being lined. Construction continues.
- Stream Walks – Stream walks are being conducted in order to evaluate stream conditions and to identify illicit discharges. The consultant is scheduled to complete the stream walks in December.
- Bacteria Source Tracking – Samples will be taken in the City’s impaired waters to determine the cause of the fecal coliform impairment. The consultant has been given the notice to proceed. Samples will be taken for evaluation during qualifying weather events.
