

Week in Review: Week Ending 10-27-2017

## PUBLIC SAFETY

### SSPD

#### North District

##### Crime:

- There were 15 *entering autos* and one burglary reported this past week. The burglary was in an apartment complex. Most of the *entering autos* occurred inside apartment complexes, with one occurring in the LA Fitness parking lot on Roswell Road.
- One woman was killed in a traffic fatality that occurred during morning rush hour. A wheel that had come loose from a northbound traveling truck struck a vehicle traveling southbound, killing the occupant of the car.

#### South District

##### Crime:

- The Chevron on Mount Vernon Hwy was burglarized and entry was made through a wall inside the exterior utility room. The suspect, a black male, was seen on video stealing cash and merchandise.
- Two apartments were burglarized. No force was used in either, and cash was reported stolen in both incidents.
- On Hilderbrand Drive, a victim's car window was broken and her gym bag and purse were taken.

#### Street Crimes Unit (SCU)

- The unit reported five misdemeanor arrests, four City Arrests, 11 traffic stops, and issued eight Citations. The unit reported seven suspicious persons/vehicles, worked six drug complaints, spent seven hours on surveillance, and conducted seven knock and talks. The unit spent more than 61 hours assisting other units, and 30 hours assisting other agencies. The unit seized 7.1 grams of marijuana, 2.7 grams of meth, and one gun.
- The unit answered an *entering auto* in progress call on Hammond Drive and arrested a subject for Loitering/Prowling and Disorderly Conduct (Drug Possession).
- The unit assisted ATF with execution of a search warrant at a condominium on Roswell Road. Several guns were located and seized, and two subjects were arrested.
- The unit made a *suspicious vehicle* stop and found three subjects smoking marijuana inside. All three were arrested and charged with drug charges. One of the subjects was arrested last month by the Street Crimes Unit for shooting at another individual during an armed robbery.

### Traffic Unit

- The unit made six misdemeanor arrests, one City arrest, and two DUI arrests. The unit conducted 167 traffic stops and issued 177 Citations. The unit spent 17.25 hours working traffic complaints, located three wanted persons, and made two field contacts. The unit was assigned seven new cases for investigation, cleared six cases, and had one callout.
- The unit worked a speed enforcement complaint on Abernathy Rd.
- The unit also provided assistance with the Citizen's Police Academy class and assisted Patrol with DUI arrests.

### K-9 Unit

- The unit attended the Cherokee County Street Smart K9 Workshop hosted by Cherokee County Sheriff's Office. The K-9 teams worked on a variety of advanced training techniques and were exposed to real-world scenarios including: felony traffic stops, traffic stops with K-9 sniffs, deploying the K-9 through open vehicle windows, vehicle assaults with other officers and K-9, building clearing with the K-9 with and without back-up officers, narcotics detection with hundreds of distraction odors present, munitions training with the K-9 and live fire exercises with the K-9.

### Criminal Investigations Division

- Credit Card Fraud: A credit card was fraudulently used after the victim's vehicle was broken into in Cobb County. The suspects illegally attempted to deposit stolen checks into an account in Cullman, AL. Contact was made with Cullman detectives to share information, and it was learned that the case is now a federal one, with a large number of individuals arrested. The incident report and notes of this case were forwarded to Cullman, AL for prosecution there.

### Volunteers

- The Citizens on Patrol Unit worked 165 hours and conducted 28 shifts this past week. They conducted 14 house checks and issued 21 handicap-parking citations covering 856 patrol miles.
- They handled eight Private Property accidents and distributed SR13 forms.

### SSFR

#### Operations:

- Responded to a total of 284 calls: One fire, 86 EMS calls, 29 Service Calls, 124 Good Intent Calls, 24 False Alarms
- Units responded to the 400 block of Sandlewood Drive for a possible structure fire. No active fire was present. The vent fan in the downstairs bathroom of a unit had caught fire and dripped melted plastic onto the porcelain toilet which then broke the toilet. The fire was out prior to the arrival of fire units. Crewmembers checked the fan and surrounding areas with a thermal imaging camera and found no hazards or any alarming heat signatures.
- Units responded to the 5100 block of Lake Forrest Drive on reports of a motor vehicle crash and found a sport utility style vehicle on its side in the north bound lane of Lake Forrest Drive with a broken power pole next to the south bound lane. The pole was still standing with wires sagging across the road. Georgia Power was contacted.

Inspections:

- There were 80 inspections conducted with nine violations cited.

Fire Training:

- Company Level Training: Hurst E-Tools combination cutters use and maintenance, hose loads, Fireground Hydraulics, New Driver Hydraulic scenarios, saw use and maintenance, Blitz attack strategies with the RAM nozzle, building construction

EMS Training:

- SSFD members attended a Mass Casualty Incidents training class.
- SSFD provided medical standby for SSPD physical assessments.
- SSFD began department wide protocol credentialing.

Safety Education & Public Relations Events:

- SSFR oversaw 12 Public Education events with 3,352 participants: three Pre-K Fire Safety Events, two Elementary Fire Safety Events, one Parade Truck Demonstration, two Fire Warden Training and four Exit Drill Assessments.
- Three car seat inspections were conducted with three adults trained.

- The Medical Services Officer attended the American Heart Association mission lifeline quarterly meeting.
- Sandy Springs Rotary Club hosted their Annual Public Safety Awards Luncheon.

TRANSPORTATION

**PROJECTS WITH MAJOR TRAFFIC IMPACTS**

- Milling and paving work begins next week on Bluestone/Hilderbrand.
- Surveyors will be out working over the next few weeks at Dunwoody Club and Jett Ferry; Spalding & Pitts; Riverview and Northside Dr; and Mt. Paran at Powers Ferry.

**TSPLOST TIER ONE:**

TSPLOST SIDEWALKS PROGRAM: Design and survey work are in progress for the following projects:

- Windsor Parkway between Peachtree Dunwoody and City limit. Concept plans are currently in development.
- Northwood – Kingsport to Roswell Road. This project will provide sidewalk connections and pedestrian scale lighting along the south side of Northwood from Kingsport to existing sidewalk near Roswell Road. Right-of-way acquisitions efforts are planned to begin in the next few weeks.
- Brandon Mill Road – Marsh Creek to Lost Forest Drive. Design and survey work are planned to begin next month.
- Gap Fill Projects: The two sites are Windsor Parkway west of Dalmer and Spalding Drive east of Dunwoody Road. Construction is planned for later this year.
- PATH400 Trail: Two Public Information meetings were held October 25<sup>th</sup>. Approximately 60 people attended the morning session and more than 60 people attended the evening session.
- Mt. Vernon Highway Corridor Study: **A Public Information Open House is scheduled for November 14, 2017 beginning at 5:30 p.m. at the Mt Vernon Presbyterian Church.**

Traffic Efficiency Improvement Projects:

- T-7178/TS116 Dunwoody Club Drive at Jett Ferry Road  
 This project will create concepts and design plans to improve traffic operations at this intersection. Survey crews will be surveying the intersection and approach roadways over the next few weeks. Traffic counts will also be collected over the next few weeks using cameras at the intersection and tubes across the approach roadways. New stops signs are also being deployed in November that will have blinking LED lights to increase the visibility of the signs to motorists and improve safety operations.
- T-7232/TS111 Spalding Drive at Pitts Road  
 This project will create concepts and design plans to improve traffic operations at this intersection. Survey crews will be surveying the intersection and approach roadways over the next few weeks. Traffic counts will also be collected over the new few weeks using cameras at the intersection and tubes across the approach roadways.
- T-7126/TS106 Riverview Drive at Northside Drive  
 This project will create concepts and design plans to improve traffic operations at this intersection. Survey crews will be surveying the intersection and approach roadways over the next few weeks. Traffic counts will also be collected over the new few weeks using cameras at the intersection and tubes across the approach roadways.
- T-7149/TS110 Mount Paran Road at Powers Ferry Road  
 This project will construct a signal lane roundabout at the intersection of Mount Paran Road and Powers Ferry Road. The project is in the design phase. Survey crews will be surveying the intersection and approach roadways over the next few weeks.
- T-7223/TS105 SR 9 at Grogans Ferry Road  
 This project will construct a traffic signal at Roswell Road and Grogans Ferry Road and will install access management (a median) along Roswell Road in the vicinity of Grogans Ferry Road to improve safety operations. A design concept for this project has been developed and was presented at a public information open house (PIOH) on October 26, 2017.

#### CIP

- T-33 CDBG Sidewalks Roswell Road Streetscape from I-285 to Long Island: Design work to develop Overlay District-compliant streetscape on the west side of Roswell Road from I-285 to Long Island Drive continues. Right-of-way acquisition and utility coordination activities are underway.
- T-43 Glenridge Drive at Roswell Road Intersection: Project environmental coordination, utility coordination and design work continue. Right-of-way acquisition coordination with property owners is underway.
- T-58 Connector Street from Boylston to Roswell Road (Denmark Drive): Water line installation on Roswell Road is in progress with initial roadway paving to follow.
- T-62 City Springs Streetscapes and Trails: Design work is underway for three multi-use trails and streetscape near the City Springs site. Sandy Springs Circle from Mt. Vernon Highway to Johnson Ferry Road (west side): provides a multi-use side path, lighting and landscaping from Mt. Vernon Highway to the Fire Station. Johnson Ferry Road from Sandy Springs Circle to Roswell Road (north side): provides a multi-use side path, landscaping and lighting on Johnson Ferry across the street from the new Performing Arts Center and City Springs. Mt. Vernon Highway and Hilderbrand adjacent to City Springs' site: provides a connecting multi-use trail between Mt. Vernon Highway and Hilderbrand immediately adjacent to the Georgia Power Company substation. Design for all three projects is expected to be completed later this year into early next year. Construction is planned for 2018.

- Mabry Road Drainage Project: The City will bid this project with pre-qualified construction contractors. Construction is planned to begin early next year.
- Sidewalk Program:
  - Glenridge Drive at Northland Drive: Construction bidding is underway for this project with construction planned to begin later this year.

#### Transportation

- T-0044 ATMS 2 Project  
Federally funded GDOT project to install adaptive traffic control at 27 intersections on Roswell Road from Abernathy Road to the City of Atlanta Limits. Construction crews are conducting rolling lane closures (minimal impact to traffic) at night over the next few weeks to install devices in the road.

#### Field Services

- FY 2018 Resurfacing FY 2017 GDOT LMIG: The Notice of award and contract was sent to Stewart Brothers, Inc.
- Guardrails
  - Lowe Engineering will conduct inspection of all City-owned guardrails with a repair bid package to be developed following. The design scope to be awarded after inspections are completed.
- FY16 Bridge Maintenance: The bid package for repair of Windsor Parkway Bridge over Nancy Creek was posted October 25, 2017.
- Sidewalk Repairs
  - Inspections around City Springs completed October 20. Report expected early November.
- Mowing
  - Pro Cutter mowing crews worked on I-285 this week.
- Litter Pickup
  - Staff continues review of litter pickup on I-285 & SR 400.
- Pothole Repairs
  - District 5 is complete with a total of 393 potholes filled. District 6 is in progress. Riverside Drive is complete with 60 potholes filled.
- Utility Permitting and Coordination
  - 25 utility permits received.
  - 314 Utility permits are eligible to be activated that have not yet started.
  - 989 Utility permits have expired, but may be re-submitted for work.
  - Five permits were issued.
  - Two Pre-Construction meetings were held.
  - Two permits were placed on hold (1 ATT, 1 Comcast, 0 AGL, 0 Other).
  - Nine active utility projects (over 500 L.F.) are undergoing construction - 50 permits are in the process of being closed upon completion of restoration (2 AGL, 48 Comcast, 0 AT&T).
  - Four (Pending) utility permits closed out.
  - One gas leak was reported and resolved.
  - Six water leaks were reported and forwarded to City of Atlanta Department of Watershed Mgmt.
  - Three Stop Work Orders were issued due to non-compliance with City of Sandy Springs Utility Accommodation Guidelines (Comcast).

- Three resident concerns were addressed in the field by staff pertaining to restorations, water line damages, gas line damages, and general questions about the utility work. Two concerns are in the process of being resolved.
- 32 Service Ticket requests were received, and 2 Service Ticket requests were resolved.
- There are 51 active COA water leaks
  - Four - New
  - 12 - Open COA restorations
- Street Lighting
  - 14 Streetlight Issues/Outages were received.
  - Three Streetlight Issues/Outages were reported to Georgia Power.
  - 17 Street Light Issues/Outages were reported to Sandy Springs.
  - Four requests for New Streetlights were received.
  - 17 reported city lights were repaired (pending inspection).

## NATURAL RESOURCE PROTECTION

### Stormwater

- There are 69 identified projects: three are under construction, three are under design, three in contract development, one in right-of-way/easement acquisition, nine in technical review, 49 in scope development, and the remaining pending final invoice or inspection.
- Three new drainage work requests received last week.
- 430 Highbrook Drive – The project entails lining a pipe. Bids are due October 30, 2017.
- Glenridge Culvert North of Abernathy (at Marsh Creek) – A headwall will be replaced, and the culvert will be lined. Quotes are under review.
- Allen Road Park Drainage and Swale Design – A swale will be constructed and a pipe will be removed to address a drainage issue. Consultant quotes are due October 26<sup>th</sup>.
- 7185 Hunters Branch Drive – A catch basin is being re-built. A schedule will be coordinated with Chatfield Contracting after the purchase order is issued.
- Northland/Windsor Parkway – The project consists of replacing storm pipe and structures in the right-of-way at the Northland/Windsor Parkway intersection. A schedule will be coordinated with Blount Construction after the purchase order is issued.
- 1650 Brandon Hall Drive – A pipe will be lined. Construction continues.
- 7000 Central Parkway – A manhole will be lined. Construction continues.

- 7455 Talbot Colony – A portion of a storm pipe is being replaced while another portion is being lined. Construction continues.
- Stream Walks – Stream walks are being conducted in order to evaluate stream conditions and to identify illicit discharges. The consultant is scheduled to complete the stream walks in December.
- Bacteria Source Tracking – Samples will be taken in the City’s impaired waters to determine the cause of the fecal coliform impairment. The consultant has been given the notice to proceed. Samples will be taken for evaluation during qualifying weather events.
