

## PUBLIC SAFETY

### Jan. 16 Snow/Ice event

- A snowfall on Tuesday, January 16, 2018, in combination with freezing temperatures and a wind chill at zero created a coating of snow and ice throughout the city. Public Works crews began pre-treatment of roadways Tuesday afternoon, in advance of precipitation. The Emergency Operations Center was officially opened early Tuesday evening. The Emergency Operations Team consisted of staff from Police, Fire, Public Works, Communications, IT, Finance and the City Manager's office.
- Crews focused on clearing the City's priority roadways, which are determined based on public safety criteria. No injuries, fallen trees or power lines down were reported.
- Thursday afternoon Public Works activities were transitioned back to normal routine, with remaining reports of ice handled per the City's After Hours protocol.

### SSPD

#### North District

##### Crime:

- The unit reported seven *Entering Autos* and one burglary this past week. Several of the *Entering Autos* were from the parking lot outside of LA Fitness on Mount Vernon Hwy. This parking lot is adjacent to the Sandy Springs MARTA station.
- The unit reported a shooting at the Steak and Shake restaurant on Roswell Road. The victim initially reported being shot by someone, but he later confessed that it was self-inflicted.

##### Community:

- Officers attended a tabletop discussion at Northside Hospital where SSPD's response to a fictional emergency event was discussed with the hospital's security team.
- SSPD conducted a Lock Down drill at both campuses of Mount Vernon Presbyterian School.

#### South District

##### Crime:

- There was a robbery at the post office on Sandy Springs Circle. The victim attempted to sell a pair of sneakers to three suspects. One suspect distracted the victim, while the other two suspects grabbed the sneakers and fled. Two of the suspects were arrested.
- A bag containing clothes, toiletries and a checkbook were taken from a woman who was loading items into her vehicle located at 5501 Glenridge Drive. Approximately two hours later, the stolen items were returned next to the victim's vehicle.
- An apartment was unlawfully entered at 5675 Roswell Road. There were no signs of forced entry. Clothing, electronics and birth certificates were stolen.
- There was a single vehicle fatality accident in the 5300 Block of Roswell Road on January 13, 2018. A passenger was transported to the hospital related to non-life-threatening injuries.
- A 2014 Mercedes Benz ML350 was taken from a garage on Riley Place. The keys had been left inside the vehicle. There was another reported *Entering Auto* reported nearby and close in time to the reported car theft.

##### Community:

- Members of the South District participated in a weekend SWAT detail at Mercedes Benz Stadium for the College Football National Championship game.

#### Street Crimes Unit (SCU)

- The unit assisted narcotics officers with a prostitution and drug arrest.
- The unit worked a robbery detail in the area of Northwood Drive.

#### Traffic

- The unit reported ten misdemeanor arrests, conducted 98 traffic stops, and issued 125 citations. The unit spent 18 hours working traffic complaints and made six DUI arrests.
- The traffic unit is investigating the traffic fatality that occurred on January 13. The investigation is still active at this time.

#### K-9 Unit

- The unit assisted with tracking a robbery suspect, and an arrest was made.
- A traffic stop resulted in an arrest for parole violation and securing of a stolen handgun.
- The unit worked with postal inspectors on a federal search warrant. The K-9 located \$60K in cash.

#### Special Investigations Unit (SIU)

- Kenndric Roberts was indicted for 62 counts of human trafficking, including a RICO charge. This case stems from the arrest at Strauss Lane.

#### Criminal Investigations Division

- Person Shot- Steak 'n Shake on Roswell Rd.: An employee had a pistol in his pocket and accidentally shot himself in the leg, while the gun was inside his pocket. The victim and a witness both lied to police, stating that the victim had been shot by someone in a silver sedan. The victim's vertical entrance and exit wound did not align with the story. Video surveillance confirmed that the victim shot himself. Both victim and witness were cited and released for Disorderly Conduct and making false statements to police.
- Person shot - 5600 block of Peachtree Dunwoody Rd.: A shooting victim was dropped off at the curb in front of Northside Hospital. The investigation revealed that the shooting took place in Midtown Atlanta, and Atlanta PD is now handling the case.
- Road Rage -1001 Johnson Ferry Road: The victim honked her vehicle horn and took emergency action to avoid a collision with the suspect's vehicle. The suspect blocked the victim's vehicle, exited her car, and after arguing with the victim, pepper sprayed the victim. The suspect was contacted by police and agreed to come in. The suspect was cited for Disorderly Conduct.
- Shots fired - 5801 Kingsport Drive: Eight gun shots were heard by residents during the night, but no one called 911. The next morning, residents discovered three cars and an apartment had been hit by the gunfire. One projectile was turned in as evidence.
- Burglary at 8300 block of Roswell Road: The victim was in his bedroom, when he heard a noise coming from the front of the home. The victim thought it was his husband and went to greet him. The victim saw an unknown black male standing inside the house. The suspect fled.
- Larceny from Vehicle/Loitering and Prowling, N. Mill Rd.: The victim was alerted by his dog barking and checked his security cameras. He observed a white male wearing a baseball cap and face covering, going through his carport. The victim scared the suspect who fled.

#### Community Affairs

- Officers participated in a Citizen' Patrol Training class and Firearm Safety class.

#### Volunteers

- The Citizens on Patrol Unit worked 116 hours and conducted 18 shifts this past week. They conducted nine house checks and issued 14 handicap-parking citations, covering 626 patrol miles.
- They handled five Private Property accidents and distributed SR13 forms.

## SSFR

### Operations:

- Responded to a total of 281 calls: five fires, 87 EMS calls, 37 Service Calls, 118 Good Intent Calls, 24 False Alarms
- Units were dispatched to the 5500 block of Glenridge Drive for a possible structure fire and found a four-story multifamily dwelling with no indication of fire from the exterior. A neighboring tenant advised that he could hear the smoke alarm going off in the unit next to his. Personnel were able to hear the smoke alarm and smelled a faint odor of smoke. They found the unit filled with moderate smoke conditions. A pot of food on the stove had started smoldering and smoking; no other fire conditions were found.
- Units responded to a fire in a storm drain on I-285 Eastbound at Glenridge Drive. Personnel extinguished the fire.
- Units responded to the 700 block of Brookwoods Trace on a reported structure fire. The homeowner stated that there was a haze in the basement, and he was unsure of what it was. Personnel encountered a light haze and an odor consistent with chlorine. After putting on full personal protective equipment, personnel re-entered and located a plastic box containing chlorinating granules and a plastic bag with four small cans of pipe cement / glue. The pipe glue and the chlorine had mixed together and began heating up, putting off the haze and odor throughout the home.
- Units were dispatched to the intersection of Roswell Road and Glenridge Drive on reports of a vehicle fire. Personnel applied a dry chemical extinguisher to the source of the fire. The owner stated that he was carrying elevator batteries and circuit boards. He believed a battery may have caught on fire.

### Inspections:

- There were 81 inspections conducted with 30 violations cited.

### EMS Training:

- SSFD conducted yearly EMS credentialing.
- SSFD held a National Registry Emergency Medical Responder practical testing with eight students successfully completing the course.
- Nine TEMS members attended a two-day SWAT training session.
- The Fire Marshal's Office personnel completed CPR and EMS certification refresher training.

### Safety Education & Public Relations Events:

- SSFR oversaw two public education events with 64 participants: one birthday party, and one station tour.
- One car seat inspection was conducted with two adults trained.

## TRANSPORTATION

### PROJECTS WITH MAJOR TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Geotechnical borings will be conducted on the east side of Brandon Mill Road, Tuesday, January 23<sup>rd</sup> between 9 am to 2 pm. The northbound lane on Brandon Mill Road from Marsh Creek to just south of North Mill Road will be closed.
- On Jan 22, 25 and 26, between 5-5:30 a.m., intermittent traffic pacing will take place in the left lane of GA 400 NB at the Mt Vernon Hwy overpass for work related to the Transform 285/400 project by GDOT.

Public Works crews focused on treatment and clearing of city roadways following the Tuesday evening snowfall, which left an inch of snow and ice throughout the city. The emergency operations period ended Thursday afternoon.
