

Week in Review: Week Ending 5-25-2018

PUBLIC SAFETY

SSPD

North District

Crime:

- The unit reported one robbery, two burglaries and three *entering autos* this past week. The robbery was domestic, a stolen cell phone. Both burglaries occurred in apartment complexes.

Community:

- Several CRASE (Citizen Response to Active Shooter Events) classes were held.
- Community officers participated in the HOA meeting for the Rivergate community, and attended the High-Five Friday event at Woodland Elementary School.

South District

Crime:

- The District recorded eight *entering auto* incidents. In one case, two laptops, two pistols, computer equipment, and a camera were stolen. The estimated value of those items was more than \$13,000.
- There were four burglaries with three taking place in single-family homes and one occurring at storage unit.

Community:

- The Community Officer attended the North Metro Crime Prevention Meeting.

Street Crimes Unit (SCU)

- The unit reported one felony arrest, two misdemeanor arrests, conducted nine traffic stops, and issued one Citation. The unit arrested three wanted persons, made two field contacts, and conducted one suspicious person / vehicle stop, and one vehicle search. The unit spent 31 hours conducting surveillance, conducted four knock and talks, and issued one arrest warrant.
- Officers attended National Police Week in Washington DC as part of the Honor Guard.
- The unit worked an *entering auto* detail at 1155 Mt. Vernon Hwy.

TRAFFIC

- The unit reported seven misdemeanor arrests, three DUI arrests, conducted 98 traffic stops, and issued 131 Citations. The unit arrested one wanted person, spent 18 hours working traffic complaints, and issued four search warrants.
- The TRV reported 10 traffic stops, issued 11 Citations, impounded one vehicle, conducted three patrol assists, changed one flat tire, answered four gas calls, and answered 27 total calls and one jump start.

K-9 Unit

- The unit reported three misdemeanor arrests, one City arrest, and arrested three wanted persons. The unit conducted 14 traffic stops, issued 16 Citations, worked 15 drug complaints, conducted 15 knock and talks, and two K-9 searches. The unit seized seven grams of marijuana, one gun, and \$160,404 in cash.
- A traffic stop in the Hammond / Peachtree Dunwoody corridor resulted in an arrest for marijuana and a gun seized, and a separate traffic stop resulted in the arrest of a located wanted person.
- The unit assisted the DEA/FIT team with a K-9 sniff on US Currency with \$160,404 seized.

Bicycle Unit

- The unit made a Felony drug arrest on Carpenter Dr. (MDMA, Marijuana, and Heroin).

Criminal Investigations Division

- Devin Kingdom was found guilty on all counts in his trial related to a murder, which took place on North River Driver in 2016. A hung jury was reported for a second suspect, Malik Ortiz, who was at the scene, but did not shoot anyone. Ortiz will be held without bond pending re-trial.
- The jury was not able to reach a decision in the murder case related to the overdose death of a nine-month old baby. Tonya Monroe is accused of the 2016 murder of her grandson, Kobe Shaw. The jury hung 11 to 1, and Monroe will be held without bond pending re-trial.
- Person Shot/Stolen auto: A rolling domestic down I-285 resulted in the passenger/victim shooting herself in the head. The victim is a heroin addict, HIV positive, and has a history of suicide attempts. Her boyfriend crashed the car after the shooting, and a Good Samaritan took them to the hospital. The boyfriend then stole the Good Samaritan's car and fled the hospital. The female victim is on life support at Grady, and is not expected to live. The stolen car was recovered in Dekalb County. The identity of the boyfriend has not been established.
- Theft of Services, Comfort Inn, Roswell Road: The offender, Casey Shelton, stayed at the hotel from December 27, 2017 until January 24, 2018, with the stay paid for by his employer. Shelton was terminated by his employer, but continued to live in the hotel room until March 21, 2018, and presented the housing payment card for payment. The hotel did not receive payment and contacted the company. The bill for the unauthorized stays total more than \$4,000. A warrant was issued for his arrest.
- Entering Auto, Publix, Powers Ferry Road: The victim witnessed two males pry open the door handle to her Jeep and steal her purse. She confronted them and obtained the tag of their vehicle, a Hertz rental, white Chevy Malibu. The investigation continues.
- Theft by Taking, AT&T, Roswell Road: A female suspect entered the AT&T store and asked to purchase a phone. When the employee went to the back of the store to retrieve the phone, the suspect switched the employee's iPad on the table with an iPad she brought into the store. The action matches the M.O. of a case under investigation by Douglasville PD; however, surveillance footage was of a different female in this case. The District LP Manager of AT&T indicated that these iPads are being stolen for customer information. The customer information is then used fraudulently.
- Motor Vehicle Theft from Jan. 2017: A Honda CBR 600 motorcycle, stolen from a parking deck, was involved in a vehicle pursuit by Georgia State Patrol. The motorcycle was wrecked, and the driver apprehended and charged.
- Prostitution, Person Shot: SIU and SCU, along with FBI agents, conducted an undercover prostitution operation targeting juvenile victims. One female arrived at the location, who was determined to be 17-years old, driven to the location by an adult male, later identified as Jaquan Barnes. In the process of apprehending Barnes, he was shot. The investigation shows Barnes was in possession of a stolen firearm out of Beaufort, SC and a stolen vehicle out of Horry County, SC. Barnes also has a probation warrant for burglary from the SC Parole Board, along with five felony warrants out of the Horry County, SC PD. Barnes was arrested and charged by SSPD with Aggravated Assault on police, Felony Obstruction, Human Trafficking, Possession of a firearm by a Convicted Felon and Possession of a Firearm during Commission of a Felony. The female was a runaway from South Carolina and a victim of human trafficking. She was turned over to Children's Healthcare with a DFACS referral and later released to her mother. South Carolina DFACS is involved in the case.

Community Affairs

- Classes taught this week: Citizen's Gun Safety Class and a Women's Self Defense Class.
- Chief DeSimone attended the Sandy Springs Interfaith Clergy Association luncheon.

Volunteers

- The Citizens on Patrol Unit worked 239 hours and conducted 21 shifts this past week. They conducted 25 house checks and issued 33 handicap-parking citations, covering 1,048 patrol miles.
- They handled 13 Private Property accidents and distributed SR13 forms.

SSFD

Operations:

- Units responded to a total of 270 calls: Five fires, 90 EMS calls, 30 Service Calls, 106 Good Intent Calls, and 28 False Alarms.
- Units were dispatched to the 7200 block of Roswell Road to reports of a shorted electrical hazard and found a blown transformer on a secondary distribution pole that was actively arcing near a car sales lot. The owner stated that she heard a loud bang and that she no longer had electricity. No fire was found, and the breaker on the transformer was tripped, preventing power to the building. The crew notified Georgia Power and remained on scene until their arrival.
- Units were dispatched to the 1400 block of Glenridge / Stratford Drive on reports of a dumpster fire. Crew members were able to successfully extinguish the fire with water.

Inspections:

- There were 146 inspections conducted with eight violations cited.

Safety Education & Public Relations Events:

- SSFD oversaw three events with 2,050 participants: one birthday party, one exit drill evaluation, and one public education event.
- One car seat inspection was conducted with one adult trained.

TRANSPORTATION

PROJECTS WITH MAJOR TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Dangerous tree removed Wed., May 30, 2018, at 470 Morgan Falls Road. The eastbound lane will be closed while the work is underway.
- The closures at Barfield and Mt Vernon will continue as part of the Transform 285/400 project. Expect delays, especially during peak travel times in this area. Motorists are urged to be patient and not try to circumvent the signals, as it creates especially dangerous conditions.
- GDOT is also conducting traffic pacing as part of blasting activities surrounding the Transform 285/400 project. Blasting will take place Monday – Friday between 1:30 – 2:00 pm each day, with pacing on I-285 east and westbound, and on Perimeter Center Parkway. Traffic on Perimeter Center Parkway, from Lake Hearn Drive to Hammond Dr. will be stopped before and during the blasting operation.

The City maintains a **Road Work Advisory page** with updates on all planned lane and road closures and advisories. You can receive weekly traffic updates and emergency traffic alerts via email and/or text by signing up for **Sandy Springs Alerts**.

TSPLOST TIER ONE

- TSPLOST SIDEWALKS PROGRAM: Design and survey work are in progress for the following projects:
 - Windsor Parkway between Peachtree Dunwoody and City limit: Utility relocation coordination and right-of-way acquisition efforts continue.
 - Northwood – Kingsport to Roswell Road: Right-of-way acquisitions efforts and utility coordination continue.
 - Brandon Mill Road – Marsh Creek to Lost Forest Drive: Design and survey work are underway.
- Traffic Efficiency Improvement Projects:
 - TS103 – Spalding Dr. at Dalrymple Road-Trowbridge Road: Final Plans for upgraded signal operation and additional turn lanes have been reviewed by staff and comments returned to the consultant. Right-of-way activities continue.

CIP

- CC-10 Sandy Springs Circle Streetscape, Phase II: Utilities are preparing to begin relocation work within the next two months. Project construction is scheduled to begin late summer 2018.
- T-43 Glenridge Drive at Roswell Road Intersection Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) is planning a Final Field Plan Review for early next month. City right-of-way acquisition efforts are ongoing in coordination with adjacent property owners.
- T-58 Connector Street from Boylston to Roswell Road (Denmark Drive): Construction punch list items and completion of project lighting remain to be finished.
- Mabry Road Drainage Project: Construction continues installing the new drainage system. Utility relocations in conjunction with the construction project are also ongoing.
- Sidewalk Program:
 - Brandon Mill from West Spalding to Marsh Creek Bridge Sidewalk: Construction is complete.
 - Glenridge Drive at Northland Drive: Construction is complete.
 - Dudley Lane Sidewalk: Construction bids are under review.

Transportation

- T-0044 ATMS 2 Project - Work is complete.
- Project DK-427 (PI 0012631) Perimeter Activity Center - ITS (intelligent transportation systems) Upgrades and System Expansion construction completed of an additional northbound left turn lane on Peachtree Dunwoody Road to westbound Hammond Drive and added flashing yellow arrows to the intersections of Peachtree Dunwoody Road at Mt. Vernon Highway, Peachtree Dunwoody Road at Hammond Drive, and Johnson Ferry Road at Glenridge Drive. Installation of five new CCTVs is underway.
