

Week in Review: Week Ending 7-27-2018

PUBLIC SAFETY

SSPD

North District

Crime:

- The unit reported five *Entering Autos*, four burglaries, and one robbery this past week.
 - Three of the *Entering Autos* were unlocked and one other was a theft of a license plate.
 - The robbery was a strong-armed robbery of \$20. Suspect in the robbery is a juvenile.
 - One of the burglaries was at the GNC in the 8700 block of Roswell Road.

South District

Crime:

- The unit reported ten *Entering Autos* in the South District during the week with no distinct pattern. Two of the incidents occurred at a restaurant located on Sandy Springs Circle. A firearm was taken from one of the vehicles.
- There was one commercial burglary reported which occurred overnight at a Dialysis center on Lake Hearn Drive. Concentrate lines on the dialysis machines were cut. There was no forced entry to the business and nothing was taken.
- Traffic Fatality: There was a single vehicle traffic fatality, which occurred on GA 400 south at I-285 WB in the construction zone. An SUV struck the median and overturned several times killing a passenger. The traffic unit is investigating.

Community:

Street Crimes Unit (SCU)

- The unit reported one felony arrest, three city arrests, 20 traffic stops, 20 citations issued, four field contacts, 13 suspicious persons/vehicles, one vehicle search, worked 110 surveillance hours, one knock and talk, nine hours assisting other units, one hour assisting other agencies, three active cases.

- Assisted Traffic Unit with fatality crash investigation on GA 400 S at Hammond Dr.

- Suspicious vehicle/person call on Pine Mill Lane. SCU located the vehicle with two subjects arrested for loitering/prowling and disorderly conduct. Further investigation is being conducted due to their possible involvement in fraud/theft.

TRAFFIC

- The unit reported four misdemeanor arrests, two city arrests, one DUI arrest, conducted 100 traffic stops, issued 132 citations, spent 3.5 hours working traffic complaints and 19 hours assisting other units, and had one callout.
- Fatality on GA 400.
- Assisted with Funeral escort for Ann Nable.
- TRV 1 and 2 reported two misdemeanor arrests, 18 traffic stops, issued 34 citations and impounded three vehicles. The units answered 10 crash calls, had 24 patrol assists, changed seven flat tires, answered 11 gas calls and 61 total calls, performed three jump starts, and spent nine hours assisting other units.

Criminal Investigations Division

- Motor Vehicle Theft in the 1100 block Hammond Dr: 2018 Chevy Camaro stolen from parking deck. Drag marks located at scene consistent with a tow-truck towing the vehicle. Incident possibly linked to other tow-truck related cases and CID is working with CIU to confirm.

SSFD

Operations:

- Responded to a total of 305 calls: Four fires, 96 EMS calls, 35 Service Calls, 128 Good Intent Calls, 28 False Alarms
- Units responded to a fire near the intersection of Roswell Road and Dalrymple Road and discovered a small fire at the base of a cedar tree located behind a pharmacy store. Personnel used a water can to extinguish the fire.
- Units responded to children locked in a car in the 8800 block of Dunwoody Place. Crews arrived on scene and found the mother outside of the car and stated that she had accidentally locked the children inside with her keys in the trunk. Personnel were able to get inside the car using the lock out tool and the children were fine.
- Units responded to the 7000 block of Central Parkway on reports of a person stuck inside a stalled elevator. The crews used technical rescue equipment and ground ladders to make entry into the elevator car from the top. Once inside the elevator car, personnel confirmed that the two persons inside the elevator had no medical complaints or injuries. The elevator technician arrived on scene and was able to move the car from where it had stalled up to the 11th floor. SSFD extricated the persons without incident.
- Units responded to a dumpster fire in the 6000 block of Heard's Drive. Upon arrival and found a 15-yard dumpster sitting on the driveway with construction debris on fire. SSFD extinguished the fire and completed overhaul.

Training:

- Division Chief Doug Brown and Deputy Fire Marshal Jesse Bernard attended Georgia Fire Inspector Association training on changes to the IBC and building construction.

Safety Education & Public Relations Events:

- SSFD oversaw five events with 162 participants: two birthday parties, two fire warden training events, and one station tour.
- One car seat inspection was conducted with one adult trained.

TRANSPORTATION

PROJECTS WITH MAJOR TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- GDOT will begin work in late June to relocate Ga. Power transmission poles along Abernathy Road, from Glenridge Dr to Peachtree Dunwoody Rd. The work is expected to take approximately six months. The work will require traffic pacing, single, and multiple lane closures - both day and night.
- **Monday - Friday 1:30 - 2:00 p.m. - GDOT will conduct traffic packing on I-285 eastbound and westbound, and on Perimeter Center Parkway as granite blasting is conducted.** Traffic on Perimeter Center Parkway, from Lake Hearn Drive to Hammond Drive will be stopped before and during the blasting operation. Expect blasting to occur until end of the year.

The City maintains a **Road Work Advisory page** with updates on all planned lane and road closures and advisories. You can receive weekly traffic updates and emergency traffic alerts via email and/or text by signing up for **Sandy Springs Alerts**.

TSPLOST TIER ONE

TSPLOST SIDEWALKS PROGRAM: Design and survey work are in progress for the following projects:

- Windsor Parkway between Peachtree Dunwoody and City limit: This project provides sidewalk connections on the south side of Windsor Parkway to complete the sidewalk system along this roadway. Utility relocation coordination and right of way acquisition efforts continue.
- Northwood – Kingsport to Roswell Road: This project will provide sidewalk connections and pedestrian scale lighting along the south side of Northwood from Kingsport to existing sidewalk near Roswell Road. Right of way acquisitions efforts and utility coordination continue. Bids are currently under review.
- Brandon Mill Road – Marsh Creek to Lost Forest Drive: Design and survey work are underway for this sidewalk project to extend the sidewalk network on Brandon Mill Road. Right-of-way acquisition efforts are now underway.
- Traffic Efficiency Improvement Projects:
 - TS103 – Spalding Dr. at Dalrymple Road-Trowbridge Road: Right-of-way acquisition efforts are underway for this project upgrading the signal and additional turn lanes.
 - TS106 – Northside Dr. at Riverview-Old Powers Ferry: Additional surveying is underway to determine the wall concept for this intersection improvement project.

CIP

- CC-10 Sandy Springs Circle Streetscape, Phase II: Utilities are preparing to begin relocation work within the next two months. Staff finalizing bid package. Project construction is scheduled to begin late 2018.
- T-34 Morgan Falls Road: GDOT approved award of contract to TriScapes. Pre-construction conference held June 8, 2018. Construction currently scheduled to begin August, 2018.

- Mabry Road Drainage Project: The project installs a new storm water drainage system on Mabry Road along with impacted roadway and driveway restoration. Construction continues installing the new drainage system.
- Sidewalk Program:
 - Glenridge Drive at Northland Drive: Construction punch list items including pedestrian lighting remain to be completed.
 - Dudley Lane Sidewalk: Construction is currently scheduled to begin July 2018.

STORMWATER

- Currently 72 identified projects, of which: eight are under design, five are in contract development, two in right-of-way/easement acquisition, eleven in technical review, 43 in scope development, and the remaining pending final invoice or inspection.
- 12 new drainage work requests were received last week.
- 4542 Meadow Valley Drive – Catch basin tops were replaced. The project is complete.
- 405 River Glen Trace – A pipe will be replaced. Butch Thompson is scheduled to start construction August 3rd, weather permitting. Intermittent lane closures will be required during construction.
- 30 Saddleview Run – Catch basins will be sealed. A schedule will be coordinated with Site Engineering.
- 6115 Riverwood Drive – A pipe will be lined. Bids were due June 18th. Proshot Concrete was the only bidder. A contract has been routed for review and signature.
- 535 Bridgewater Drive – The project consists of lining part of a storm pipe run, replacing part of a storm pipe run, and replacing a catch basin. Bids were due June 18th. Site Engineering appeared to have the lowest price. A contract has been routed for review and signature.
- 1107 Crest Valley Road – A culvert will be replaced and catch basins will be installed. Easement coordination is in progress with affected residents. Plan revisions will be made in response to feedback.
- 200 Gold Creek Court – A cross drain will be replaced and a storm pipe will be lined. Site Engineering was the only bidder. A contract was routed for review and signature.
- 465 Bridges Creek Trail – A pipe and two catch basins will be replaced. Pricing is due August 1st.
- Glenridge Culvert North of Abernathy (at Marsh Creek) – A headwall will be replaced and a culvert will be lined. A preliminary set of plans has been issued. The consultant is coordinating with affected utilities and adjacent property owners.
