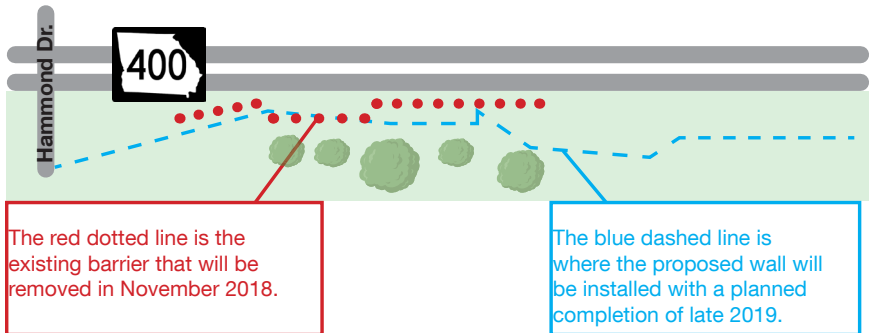
NOISE BARRIER REMOVAL

The Georgia Department of Transportation (Georgia DOT) appreciates you being a community partner with the Transform 285/400 project. As part of the construction efforts, crews will begin removing existing noise barriers in your area.

5 Things You Need To Know:

1. The noise barrier on SR 400 northbound between Hammond Drive and Mount Vernon Highway will be removed.
2. Removal will begin November 26 and last approximately two to three weeks.
3. The new noise barrier will be constructed with a planned completion of late 2019.
4. The noise barrier is being removed to allow crews to excavate and construct drainage systems, retaining walls, bridges, and collector-distributor lanes.
5. Construction activities will take place on weekdays and weekends, during the day and night.

Please anticipate additional noise due to traffic and construction activities.



ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Transform 285/400 project is designed to help reduce traffic congestion and enhance safety in the area near the I-285/SR 400 interchange in metro Atlanta. This priority project adds new flyover ramps, new collector-distributor lanes, and other facilities to aid east-west travel along I-285 and north-south travel along SR 400. The project is anticipated to complete in late-2020.

- Improve operational efficiency
- Save 20,000 hours per day
- Reduce weaving
- Improve ramp geometry within the I-285/SR 400 interchange
