ITEM: Approval for the Mayor to sign the List of Roadways for submittal to GDOT for funding under the Local Maintenance and Improvement Grant.

Public Works Department's Recommendation:

Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Council approve the included list of streets for consideration by the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) for the City's fiscal year 2014 Local Maintenance and Improvement Grant (LMIG) submission.

Background:

GDOT allows submissions by local governments for funding of projects within city, county or state rights-of-way annually. In furtherance of Operation Pave On, the Public Works Department staff has compiled a list of roads in need of resurfacing to submit to GDOT for funding under this grant which is due to GDOT by January 1, 2014.

Discussion:

Representing approximately 1.48 miles of roads, the list was compiled using the 2012 Road Rating. The streets represent designations such as arterial, collector, and local that have low Pavement Condition Index (PCI) scores and are in need of resurfacing.

With the failure of the Transportation Act to pass in 2012, a 30% local match is now required with the Local Maintenance and Improvement Grant. According to the GDOT formula amount tables, the City of Sandy Springs should receive \$635,677.23. However, in order to receive this funding, the City must submit projects with estimated construction costs that equal 30% over that amount, or \$826,380.40.

Staff estimates the amount to perform the work associated with the attached project list, is \$827,000.00. Staff recommends that the City bid this work in conjunction with the FY 2015 capital resurfacing program in order to ensure expenditure of the grant and the required 30% match. Failure to expend the grant and match may result in the forfeiture of the grant.

Alternatives:

The City may choose to apply these grant funds toward another approved use such as intersection improvements, replacing storm drain pipes or culverts, bridge repair or replacement, and/or signal installation.

Financial Impact:

If the City chooses to submit the roads listed above, the financial impact to the City will be the 30% required match of \$190,703.17, plus any funds that may be above and beyond that amount to complete the submitted list.







Proposed FY 2014 GDOT LMIG Resurfacing


