

Week in Review: Week Ending 3-22-2019

## **PUBLIC SAFETY**

SSPD

North District

Crime:

- The unit reported seven *entering autos* with an arrest made after one incident at the tennis center. Through inter-departmental communication, Forsyth County Sheriff's Office located the suspects and arrested them after a brief pursuit.
- Two burglaries were reported at apartment communities.

South District

Crime:

- The unit reported nine *entering auto* incidents in the South District. Purses, bags, wallets, and license plates were taken.
- There was one burglary reported in the 1100 block of Hammond Dr. The package room of an apartment complex was forced open, but nothing was reported stolen.

Street Crimes Unit (SCU)

- The unit reported nine felony arrests, two misdemeanor arrests, and three city arrests. The unit conducted 28 traffic stops, issued 14 citations and located three wanted persons. The unit made two field contacts, investigated eight suspicious persons, and conducted three vehicle searches. The unit worked four drug complaints, conducted 15 surveillance hours and five knock and talks. Six arrest warrants were issued, one case cleared and one case assigned.

Traffic Unit:

- The unit reported eight misdemeanor arrests, conducted 108 traffic stops, and issued 141 citations.
- The unit made three DUI arrests and four traffic arrests.
- TRV
  - The unit conducted five traffic stops, issued 13 citations, conducted three vehicle impounds, and worked four crash calls. The unit conducted 12 patrol assists, changed one flat tire, and handled four gas calls.

K-9

- The unit reported one city arrest, conducted 20 traffic stops, and issued 21 traffic citations. The unit made 15 K-9 searches, worked 32 drug complaints, conducted 31 knock/talks, and issued five search warrants. The unit seized one g. cocaine, .25g heroin, 52 THC vape pens, one gun, and \$200,000 in cash.
- A Knock and talk in the 1100 block of Hammond Dr. resulted in two drug arrests and seizure of one concealed handgun.

- Incidents:

- Sandy Springs Place Shoplifting: During a business check, an SSPD officer observed the offender struggling with an employee. The suspect attempted to run from the location, but was quickly detained by the officer. The offender attempted to fill up a cart of groceries and leave the store without paying for the items, but was stopped by the employee.

#### Criminal Investigations Division

- Person Shot- Cedar Run: The victim heard an argument outside of his door and while he was looking through the peephole, he was shot in the lower right leg. A person of interest was identified and interviewed. The suspect claimed someone broke into his apartment, and he was protecting himself. Following additional interviews with the suspect's girlfriend and victim, CID is seeking charges against the suspect.
- Damage to Property - 400 SB/Northridge Rd: A citizen was driving on the freeway, and the driver of another vehicle threw something from the window damaging the victim's windshield. The victim obtained a tag number, and CID was able to identify a suspect. The suspect paid for damage to the victim's car.
- Burglary - 5675 Roswell Rd: Unknown suspects entered a maintenance storage shed and stole a washer and dryer. There is no video, and no serial numbers were available for the washer and dryer.
- Damage to Property/Larceny - Roswell Rd: A group of suspects broke into multiple storage units throughout the Public Storage business. At this time, nothing was reported stolen by any of the storage tenants. Management is still attempting to contact all tenants effected. Video is available.
- Motor Vehicle Theft - Roswell Rd: The Illinois State Police later recovered a vehicle stolen from the Citgo gas station in Sandy Springs. A suspect who was inside the vehicle.
- Theft of Service -: Barfield Rd - The suspect obtained \$3,950 of cosmetic services from the Premier Image Cosmetic Center and failed to pay for the services. The suspect refused to cooperate with the business to pay debts or to answer requests. An arrest warrant was obtained.
- Terroristic Threats - Dunwoody Pl: A female called the Invitation Homes business and threatened harm. A search warrant revealed the number used to call in the threat was sold to another carrier.
- Simple Battery - Roswell Rd: The victim reported being struck in the head at the Moustache Hookah Bar by an individual whom he has seen previously in the area. The surveillance video and a still shot from the hookah bar was of very poor quality and not useful in this investigation. The investigation continues.
- Burglary - Hammond Dr: The package room at the Citizens Apartments was forced open with an unknown tool. The package room is in a secure location accessible only to key FOB holders. A suspect was identified, and warrants are pending. Apartment management is investigating how the suspect entered the secure location.
- Robbery – Strong Arm: Roswell Rd: SSPD responded to the report of a robbery at the Shell Gas Station. The suspect purchased a pack of cigars using cash and then attempted to cash a lottery ticket, telling the clerk to "leave the drawer open, and give me the cash." The subject fled the scene when the clerk hid under the counter and called 911. The subject is described as 6'2", wearing a black knit hat and a green and silver long sleeve shirt. SSPD CID is attempting to obtain video footage of the incident. The investigation continues.

- Forgery - Roswell Rd: Detectives are investigating a case in which the victim found a fraudulent check to be written from his account at the Bank of America. Detectives sent a request to Bank of America legal, and received video evidence regarding the fraudulent transaction. Criminal warrants are forthcoming pending additional information from the victim.
- Theft - Calaveras Dr: The victim said her jewelry box containing \$11,700 worth of jewelry was missing after the company she hired, CC Associated Movers completed the move.

#### Volunteers

- The Citizens on Patrol Unit worked 187 hours and conducted 25 shifts this past week.
- They conducted seven house checks and issued 42 handicap-parking citations, covering 817 patrol miles.
- They handled three Private Property accidents and distributed SR13 forms.
- COPS handled four accidents on the roadway with SR-13 forms provided.

#### Community Affairs

- Community officers participated in the Police Academy Graduation.
- Officers visited the Zainabia Islamic Center of Atlanta.
- Officers met with Brandon Hall School to discuss police department program and attended the STEAM Showcase at North Springs High School.
- Community officers attended the Sentinel Ferry Homeowners meeting.

#### SSFD

##### Operations:

- Responded to a total of 266 calls: Eight Fires, 84 EMS calls, 27 Service Calls, 111 Good Intent Calls, 26 False Alarms
- The Deputy Fire Marshal successfully completed the course: "Managing Effective Fire Prevention Programs" at the National Fire Academy.
- Units responded to reports of a vehicle fire in the 6300 block of Powers Ferry Road. Upon arrival, the crew found an engine compartment fire. The crew extinguished the outside fire and then opened the hood to extinguish the rest of the fire.
- Units responded to reports of a transport vehicle fire on I-285 eastbound by Glenridge Drive and found a working fire with one tractor impinged on the first of two FedEx trailers it was hauling. Crews used multiple fire extinguishers to keep the fire from extending into the trailers while an additional 1.75" foam line was stretched. Personnel used the foam line to blanket the tractor and suppress the fire. Crewmembers stayed on scene until the tractor and trailers were removed from the roadway and road cleanup was completed.

- Units responded to reports of a fire at a MARTA station in the 5700 block of Peachtree Dunwoody Road. Upon arrival, MARTA Police advised the crew of a small fire on the middle rail. The third rail was not involved. Personnel found a small grease fire on the middle rail and extinguished the fire with a carbon dioxide extinguisher.

#### Inspections:

- There were 130 inspections conducted with 28 violations cited.

#### Fire Training:

- Four SSFD members attended the Structural Fire Control class at GPSTC (Georgia Public Safety Training Center). Six SSFD live fire instructors were also present to assist the academy with the training.

#### EMS Training:

- SSFD hosted a two-day defensive tactics for EMS course.
- SSFD TEMS personnel attended SWAT training.
- SSFD personnel completed National Registry license recertification.

#### Safety Education & Public Relations Events:

- SSFD oversaw four events with 217 participants: birthday party, scout fire safety education event, career fair, and active shooter training.
- SSFD personnel inspected three car seats and trained three adults.

## TRANSPORTATION

### PROJECTS WITH MAJOR TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Georgia Department of Transportation has modified the lanes on Glenridge Drive under I-285. The existing roadway was converted to one southbound lane, one northbound turn lane to I-285 westbound, and two northbound lanes. The lane modifications will help facilitate bridge construction. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout construction activities..

#### TSPLOST

- TS191 – Johnson Ferry/Mt Vernon Improvements: Field survey activities are ongoing.
- TS192 – Mt. Vernon Highway Corridor Project. This project provides multi-use path along Mount Vernon Highway, with intersection improvements at Glenridge Drive and Barfield Road.
- TS200 – SR 400 Multi-Use Path: Survey work is ongoing.
- TSPLOST Sidewalk Program: Design and survey work is underway for the following TSPLOST Sidewalk projects:

- TS137 Johnson Ferry Road at Glenridge Connector. Right-of-way acquisition efforts are now underway with adjacent property owners. Construction planned to begin fall 2019.
- TS161 Johnson Ferry Road – Harleston to Glenridge: Right-of-way acquisition efforts are now underway with adjacent property owners. Construction planned to begin summer 2019.
- TS163 Johnson Ferry Road at Glenridge Connector: Right-of-way acquisition efforts are now underway with adjacent property owners. Construction planned to begin fall 2019.
- TS164 Windsor Parkway between Peachtree Dunwoody and City Limit: Right-of-way acquisition efforts are now underway with adjacent property owners. Construction planned to begin summer 2019.
- TS167 Brandon Mill Road – Marsh Creek to Lost Forest Drive: Right-of-way acquisition efforts are now underway with adjacent property owners. Construction planned to begin summer 2019.
- TS166 Spalding Drive Widening Project from Winters Chapel Road to Holcomb Bridge Road: Design efforts are underway by Gwinnett County who will also construct the project. City of Sandy Springs is contributing to the project via a cost share agreement as part of its TSPLOST Sidewalk Program.

## CIP

### Capital Improvement Projects

- CC-10 Sandy Springs Circle Streetscape, Phase II: Utility relocation work started Jan 2019. Project construction is scheduled to begin summer 2019.
- T-33 CDBG Sidewalks Roswell Road Streetscape from I-285 to Long Island: Design work, right-of-way acquisition efforts and utility coordination are underway to develop streetscape on the west side of Roswell Road from I-285 to Long Island Drive is underway. Project construction is scheduled to begin summer 2019.
- T-35 Roswell Road Bicycle/Pedestrian Bridge over Chattahoochee River: Supporting survey work is underway. Preliminary design and environmental coordination are underway.
- T-43 Glenridge Drive at Roswell Road Intersection: Georgia Department of Transportation preparatory work is underway to realign the intersection of Glenridge Drive at Roswell Road. Construction is forecasted to begin summer 2019.
- T-62-3 Sandy Springs Circle Streetscape from Mt. Vernon Highway to Johnson Ferry Road (west side). Design is complete, and construction is planned to start in summer 2019.
- T-62-2 Trail between Mt. Vernon Highway and Hildebrand adjacent to the City Springs site. Design is expected to be completed early this year with construction beginning summer 2019.
- Peachtree Dunwoody at Telford Roadway Improvements Project will provide safety enhancements along the road near the intersection. Design and survey work are underway with a **Public Open House scheduled for March 25, 2019** at City Hall. Construction is planned for winter 2019.
- Sidewalk Program:
  - T-6019-1 Hammond Drive at Roswell Road: Design and survey work are underway. Construction is planned for fall 2019.

- T-6019-2 Blue Stone Road at Sandy Springs Place: Design and survey work are underway. Construction is planned for fall 2019.

#### Construction

- Johnson Ferry Road - Sandy Springs Circle to Roswell Road (north side): Construction activities continue to build sidewalk in front of the shopping center.
- Sandy Springs Circle Streetscape, Phase 2 – Advance Waterline Relocation: Construction of the waterline is nearing completion.
- T-34 Morgan Falls Road: Construction activities include punch list items for completion.
- Dudley Lane Sidewalk: Construction activities include work to complete remaining driveways and sidewalks along with installation of landscape materials.
- City Springs Trails
  - T-62-1 Johnson Ferry Road: Construction is underway.

#### Traffic Services

- Installation is complete for the four (4) new Radar Speed Feedback Signs (RSFS) on Johnson Ferry Road and Abernathy Road. All signs are operational.
- During March, World Fiber (Georgia DOT contractor) is relocating a signal cabinet on I-285 at Glenridge Drive for the Transform 285/400 project.
- Staff are undertaking a service enhancement to the Vehicle Approach Warning Flasher (VAWF) on High Point Road at Bransford Road. This project includes removal of vegetation along the utility lines. The project is anticipated to be completed in April 2019.
- Transportation contractors are continuing installation activities for digital blank out signs indicating time-of-day turn restrictions at Riverside Drive and Edgewater Drive. This project completes in March 2019.
- Transportation contractors are continuing installation of 22 Internally Illuminated Street Name Signs (IISNS) around City Springs. The locations are: Abernathy Road at Mercedes Benz/Glenlake Pkwy; Sandy Springs Circle at Johnson Ferry Road; Sandy Springs Circle at Mt. Vernon Hwy; Sandy Springs Circle at Galambos Way; and Mt. Vernon Highway at Bluestone Rd. The project completes in March.
- Transportation staff are replacing the uninterrupted power supply (UPS) batteries in signal cabinets at 52 locations around the city. The UPS maintains stop-and-go traffic operations during power interruptions and maintains network switch apparatus. The project will be ongoing over the next few months.
- Adaptive Signal Timing installation is underway for 30 intersections around the I-285/SR 400 interchange under CIP project T-0054. T-0054 is a \$1.6M project that received federal funding to improve traffic operations on Hammond Drive, Peachtree Dunwoody Road, Johnson Ferry Road, Glenridge Drive, and Glenridge Connector. **During the project construction, there will be short-term rolling closures for the installation of signal detection.** The project is slated to be in operation in fall 2019.
- Twenty-four (24) Radar Speed Feedback Signs (RSFS) are being upgraded at non-school locations. During the upgrade, the RSFS devices will be inactive. The project completes in April 2019.

- For Georgia Department of Transportation SR 9 Repaving Project from Sunnybrook Ln to Roswell city limits (M005651), GDOT contractors continue to restore signal detection on Roswell Road/SR 9 and side streets after 9pm. City of Sandy Springs Traffic Management Center (TMC) staff will resume application of adaptive signal timing as detection is restored.
- For Georgia Department of Transportation SR 9 Repaving Project from Atlanta city limits to I-285 (M005652), GDOT contractors are scheduled to begin repaving on April 1. Prior to repaving, GDOT contractors will be removing magnetometer detection on Roswell Road/SR 9. City of Sandy Springs Traffic Management Center (TMC) staff will monitor traffic along the Roswell Road corridor to adjust signal timing, as needed, during the duration when detection is absent to reduce travel delay.

## NATURAL RESOURCE PROTECTION

### STORMWATER

- There are 81 identified projects: five are under construction, eight are under design, two are in contract development, five in right-of-way/easement acquisition, 20 in technical review, 38 in scope development, and the remaining pending final invoice or inspection.

- Ten new drainage work requests were received last week.
- 1650 Lazy River Lane –Awaiting final invoice.
- 6251 Vernon Woods Drive –Awaiting final invoice.
- 6871 Peachtree Dunwoody Road – Construction is complete. Reviewing post-lining CCTV video and invoice.
- 550 Pickering Lane –Construction is complete. Awaiting post-lining documentation and final invoice.
- 3000 Coles Way – Two storm pipes will be lined. Construction is scheduled to start April 2; weather permitting.
- 1180 Kingston Drive – A catch basin will be replaced and sealed. Awaiting schedule from contractor.
- 600 Valley Hall Drive – A cross drain will be replaced. Awaiting schedule from contractor.
- Glenridge Culvert North of Abernathy (at Marsh Creek) – Headwalls will be replaced, and a culvert will be lined. Construction is scheduled to start in early May.
- 600 North Harbor Drive – An emergency overflow structure will be modified, and a flood wall will be built. Project was reassigned to design engineer for additional revisions.
- 1107 Crest Valley Drive – A culvert will be replaced, and a cross drain will be installed. Contractor is grubbing, clearing and installing erosion control.

Environmental Court was held on March 15, 2019 at 9:30am.

- There were 27 defendants scheduled to appear in court with 41 code, building, fire, or land violations.
  - Nine defendants with 12 charges were adjudicated with fines, probation or dismissals. There were no fines assessed.
  - Nine defendants with nine charges failed to appear.
  - Nine defendants with 18 charges were reset for future court dates.
- A homeowner was granted restitution of \$23,729 from the contract builder for failure to maintain BMP's, failure to follow approved plan, and prohibition of illicit discharge.
