

Week in Review: Week Ending 5-10 -2019

PUBLIC SAFETY

SSPD

North District

Crime:

- The Unit reported four *entering autos* and three burglaries this past week. Two of the *entering autos* occurred in the same apartment complex off of Dunwoody Place. One of the burglaries was believed to be committed by the same subject who has committed several in the same area.

South District

Crime:

- There were eight reported incidents of larceny from vehicles in the district. Two of the incidents involved landscape equipment stolen while landscapers were working. All of the other incidents occurred on commercial properties in parking lots.
- There were five reported burglaries. One occurred at a retail store, three at apartment residences, and one at a single family home.

Street Crimes Unit (SCU)

- The Unit reported three felony arrests and two misdemeanor arrests. The conducted 37 traffic stops, issued 23 citations, located six wanted persons, and made three field contacts. The unit investigated five suspicious persons, conducted two vehicle searches, and worked three drug complaints. The unit seized 28g marijuana, 4g cocaine, 1 gun, \$800 cash, and four laptops.
- The Unit assisted patrol with a domestic dispute, welfare check, and entry.
- A traffic stop resulted in a wanted person being located and marijuana, cocaine, and a gun seized. Two people were arrested on felony charges.
- A traffic stop resulted in a wanted person being located from Dekalb for felony forgery.

Traffic

- The Unit reported 17 misdemeanor arrests, conducted 109 traffic stops, and issued 168 citations. The unit located one wanted person and worked 21 hours on traffic complaints.
- There were seven DUI arrests and seven traffic violation arrests.

TRV

- The Unit reported one misdemeanor arrest, conducted two traffic stops, and issued six citations. The unit conducted one vehicle impound, worked eight crash calls, and conducted 15 patrol assists.

K-9

- The Unit reported one city arrest, worked 16 traffic stops, and issued 13 traffic citations. The unit conducted three K-9 searches, worked four drug complaints, and conducted four 4 knock/talks.
- The Unit performed two traffic stops resulting in two DUI arrests by traffic officers and one arrest when a gun was located.
- The Unit assist patrol with a wanted person located in the 6000 block of Roswell Rd.
- The Unit performed a traffic stop arrest with marijuana located.

- The unit worked three *Entering Auto* cases. A purse, iPad and soccer bag were taken. Criminal Investigations Division

CID

- Motor Vehicle Theft: Perimeter Center - A suspect was arrested for taking a 2018 Toyota 4 Runner from the REI store parking lot.
- Theft: N. Island Dr- A caregiver of an elderly mother was suspected of stealing jewelry. The case was cleared by arrest, and the suspect was transported to the Alpharetta Jail.
- Motor Vehicle Theft: Glenridge Dr- A stolen 2005 Ford Focus was located by Dunwoody PD at 4000 Dunwoody Park. The victim was notified.
- Motor Vehicle Theft: A U-HAUL box trailer reported stolen was later found by Eastman PD, and the victim was notified.
- Motor Vehicle Theft: 5900 block of Roswell Rd- A stolen 2016 Audi Q-5 was located by Atlanta PD and impounded for processing.
- Motor Vehicle Theft: Trowbridge Walk- A 2016 GMC Yukon was stolen from the victim's secured garage overnight. Suspects are believed to have entered another vehicle in the driveway to gain access to the garage door opener. Video was obtained. The victim tracked the vehicle using On-Star to the Parc at Dunwoody Apartment complex where it was recovered. Fingerprints taken from the vehicle were processed and an IAFIS hit was obtained.

- Burglary: 8800 block of Dunwoody Pl- Unknown persons forced entry into the victim's home and stole two flat screen televisions. CSI responded to the scene and recovered blood swabs believed to be from the suspect.
- Burglary: Morgan Falls Rd - Unknown suspects forced entry into a construction site and stole construction equipment from the victim. No video was available, and the detective is waiting on the detailed inventory list from the victim.
- Burglary: Mount Paran Rd- The victim's door was forced open, and her home was ransacked. Cash, jewelry, silverware and a television were stolen. Video from the Schenck School may possibly show the suspects on camera.
- Fraud: Hightower Trl - Detectives were assigned to investigate a case in which an employee stole numerous money orders from her employer. The female later made numerous deposits throughout the metro Atlanta area. The bank records were requested, and detectives were able to prove the transactions. A criminal arrest warrant was obtained.
- Fraud: Hammond Dr - An attorney wired approximately \$100,000.00 for a scheduled business deal after receiving an email from his client. The attorney was unaware that the perpetrator had sent an email from a different address requesting the money be sent elsewhere. This investigation is ongoing.
- Fraud: Wheaton Way- The victim paid a contractor \$8,100.00 for a job to be conducted at his residence. The contractor accepted the money and performed no services. The victim has attempted to contact the suspect and obtain a refund, without success. A detective also attempted to speak with the suspect, and the suspect has refused to return the detective's calls. An arrest warrant was obtained.
- Forgery: Brookside Walk- An HOA checkbook went missing from a residence, and the nanny was suspected. Numerous fraudulent transactions and attempted transactions were made on the account with the nanny's name on the checks. The victim's personal credit card was also used fraudulently. The investigation continues.
- Theft: GA400/Hammond Dr- A MINI Excavator was discovered missing from a construction site.
- Suspicious Vehicle: Glen Manor Ct- A vehicle was captured on video, which was possibly involved in mail theft and an *entering auto* that was reported in the area.
- *Entering Auto*: Roswell Rd- The victim's unlocked vehicle was entered while it was parked at the McDonalds. The victim did not notice items were missing until they got home.
- *Entering Auto*: 4900 block of Roswell Rd- The victim's vehicle was broken into while it was parked in the rear of the business. Several items were stolen from the vehicle.
- Theft: Meridian Mark Rd- An unknown person entered the victim's unlocked office, taking a wallet.
- Theft and FTC Fraud: 6600 block of Roswell Rd- The victim's wallet was stolen from an unlocked locker at LA Fitness, and several charges were made on the credit cards. The offender was identified, and five felony arrest warrants and one misdemeanor arrest warrant were obtained.

Case Disposition Updates/Sentencing

- Home invasion/Shots Fired: Hunters Trace Circle: In February 2017, Demarco Parham committed a high profile burglary at a residence and attempted to steal the victim's car. He came back 24 hours later, committed another burglary at the home next door and was in the process of stealing the victim's car when he was confronted by the homeowner. The suspect shot at the homeowner four times and stole the victim's car but left his cell phone behind. A search warrant of the cell phone led the PD to Parham and an address in Atlanta. A search warrant at his home yielded all the property from our two cases as well as property from other cases in Atlanta.
 - Demarco Parham plead guilty on 04-29-19 to Burglary in the 1st degree and Home Invasion.
 - He was sentenced to 20 years and has a mandatory ten to serve, no exceptions.
- Burglary/Arson: The leasing office at the Parc at Dunwoody Apartment Complex was set on fire and the suspect was later identified, charged, and arrested.
 - On 04-29-19, Quincy Jones entered a guilty plea and was sentenced to ten years with a mandatory two years to serve, and credit for time already served.
 - He has been banned from Sandy Springs, has to pay restitution, and must complete an anger management assessment and 240 hours of community service.

Volunteers

- The Citizens on Patrol Unit worked 184 hours and conducted 16 shifts this past week.
- They conducted five house checks and issued 30 handicap-parking citations, covering 455 patrol miles.
- They handled two Private Property accidents and distributed SR13 forms.

SSFD

Operations:

- Responded to a total of 262 calls: six Fires, 79 EMS calls, 33 Service Calls, 115 Good Intent Calls, 28 False Alarms
- Units responded to reports of a possible brush fire in the 5500 block of Roswell Road. Upon arrival, the crew found a fire pit in an apartment complex's pool area with shrubbery in the pit burning. Personnel extinguished contents of the fire pit with a water can. The crew found no danger of extension.
- Units responded to reports of a vehicle fire in the 6300 block of Powers Ferry Road. The crew located one vehicle that was fully enveloped with fire in an empty parking lot behind a vacant building. Personnel used approximately 800 gallons of water to ensure the fire was extinguished. Crewmembers cut the trunk open to check for extension and found none.
- Units responded to reports of a possible structure fire on Glenlake Parkway. The crew arrived on scene to an assisted living facility with smoke showing from the first floor apartment. The crew performed primary and secondary searches with nothing found. The crew performed an overhaul and shut down the sprinkler system to the effected apartment.
- Units responded to reports of an apartment structure fire at Northwood Drive. Upon arrival, the crew found no signs of smoke or fire. After the caller advised that workers at the apartment had set insulation on fire in the attic, the crew expanded a scuttle hole in a breezeway to inspect the attic. After investigation, it was determined that all of the affected insulation had been extinguished and removed prior to SSFD'S arrival. Personnel found no hazards at this location.
- Units responded to reports of a structure fire in the 5600 block of Roswell Road. Upon arrival, the crew investigated and found that the homeowner has extinguished the kitchen fire, likely started by cooking oil in a pan, by using a dry chemical extinguisher. The fire was confined to the kitchen and damaged the cooktop, microwave, and cabinets. The resident stated she was cooking and saw the fire flare up in the pan and was able to extinguish it with the extinguisher. Personnel checked the areas above and around the point of origin for any extension or active fire. The crew utilized a thermal imaging camera to do so and found no temperatures above 95 degrees, no surfaces hot to the touch, and no smoke in the apartment or attic.
- Units responded to reports of a structure fire in the 5800 block of Mitchell Road. The crew arrived on scene to a two-story residential building that had a small amount of smoke and flames on the rear deck of the building. The homeowner stated that she found smoke coming from the electrical outlet in the rear of her home. Personnel were able to extinguish the flames on the rear deck with a water can. Because the homeowner had left the rear door open, allowing smoke to enter the structure, ventilation was required. The crew performed salvage, overhaul, and removed the rear door and exterior wall on the Charlie side of the building to check for any extension of the flames.
- The Fire Marshal Office and the SSPD were successful in the prosecution of an arson suspect from a 2016 apartment complex leasing office fire.

Inspections:

- There were 135 inspections conducted with 72 violations cited.

Fire Training:

- SSFD completed departmental live fire drills.
- Two fire recruits began in-house recruit school.

Safety Education & Public Relations Events:

- SSFD oversaw four events with 2,072 participants: two station tours, one scout fire safety education event, and one exit drill assessment.
- SSFD personnel inspected five car seats and trained six adults.

- TS191 – Johnson Ferry/Mt Vernon Improvements: Utility and geotechnical fieldwork continue.
- TS200 – SR 400 Multi-Use Path: Survey work is nearing completion.

TSPLOST Sidewalk Program: Design and survey work is underway for the following TSPLOST Sidewalk projects:

- TS161 Johnson Ferry Road – Harleston to Glenridge: Right-of-way acquisition efforts continue with adjacent property owners. Construction planned to begin Summer 2019.
- TS164 Windsor Parkway between Peachtree Dunwoody and City Limit: Utility relocation coordination and right-of-way acquisition efforts continue with adjacent property owners. Construction planned to begin Summer 2019.
- TS167 Brandon Mill Road – Marsh Creek to Lost Forest Drive: Right-of-way acquisition efforts continue with adjacent property owners. Construction planned to begin Summer 2019.

Capital Improvement Projects

- CC-10 Sandy Springs Circle Streetscape, Phase II: Final design coordination, utility relocation, and right-of-way acquisition efforts are underway to deliver this streetscape and roadway enhancement project on Sandy Springs Circle from Mt. Vernon Road to Hammond Drive. Project construction is scheduled to begin Summer 2019.
- T-33 CDBG Sidewalks Roswell Road Streetscape from I-285 to Long Island: Design work, right-of-way acquisition efforts, and utility coordination are underway to develop streetscape on the west side of Roswell Road from I-285 to Long Island Drive is underway. Project construction is scheduled to begin Summer 2019.
- T-43 Glenridge Drive at Roswell Road Intersection: Construction is underway.
- T-62-3 Sandy Springs Circle Streetscape from Mt. Vernon Highway to Johnson Ferry Road (west side). This project will provide a multi-use side path, lighting and landscaping from Mt. Vernon Highway to the Fire Station. Design is complete and construction is planned to start in Summer 2019.
- Peachtree Dunwoody at Telford Roadway Improvements. Project will provide safety enhancements along the road near the intersection. Design and survey work are underway.

Sidewalk Program

- T-6019-1 Hammond Drive at Roswell Road: This project fills a small gap in sidewalk connectivity on the southeast corner of the intersection. Design and survey work are underway. Construction is planned for Fall 2019.
- T-6019-2 Blue Stone Road at Sandy Springs Place: This project fills a small gap in sidewalk connectivity on the northeast corner of the intersection. Design and survey work are underway. Construction is planned for Fall 2019.

Construction

- Johnson Ferry Road - Sandy Springs Circle to Roswell Road (north side): Construction activities continue.
- Sandy Springs Circle Streetscape, Phase 2 – Advance Waterline Relocation: Construction of the waterline is substantially complete.
- T-34 Morgan Falls Road: Construction activities include completion of punch list items.
- Dudley Lane Sidewalk: Construction activities include work to complete remaining driveways and sidewalks along with installation of landscape materials.
- City Springs Trails
 - T-62-1 Johnson Ferry Road: Construction continues.

Traffic Services

- Adaptive Signal Timing installation is underway for 30 intersections around the I-285/SR 400 interchange under CIP project T-0054. During the project construction, there will be short-term rolling closures for the installation of signal detection.

- Transportation staff completed a service enhancement to the Vehicle Approach Warning Flasher (VAWF) on High Point Road at Bransford Road.
- Transportation contractors completed installation activities for digital blank out signs indicating time-of-day turn restrictions at Riverside Drive and Edgewater Drive.
- Twenty-four (24) Radar Speed Feedback Signs (RSFS) are being upgraded at non-school locations. The project is anticipated to be completed in May 2019.
- Transportation contractors are installing 21 Internally Illuminated Street Name Signs (IISNS) around City Springs at: Sandy Springs Circle at Johnson Ferry Road, Sandy Springs Circle at Mt. Vernon Hwy, Sandy Springs Circle at Galambos Way, and Mt. Vernon Highway at Bluestone Rd. The project is anticipated to be completed in May 2019.

NATURAL RESOURCE PROTECTION

Stormwater

- There are 85 identified projects: five are under construction, eight are under design, four are in contract development, six in right-of-way/easement acquisition, 24 in technical review, 36 in scope development, and the remaining pending final invoice or inspection.
- Five new drainage work requests were received last week.
- 555 Glenforest Road –Awaiting final invoice.
- 6871 Peachtree Dunwoody Road –Awaiting post-lining CCTV.
- 1180 Kingston Drive –Construction is nearly complete with punch list remaining.
- 400 Northridge Parkway – Two storm pipes will be lined. Construction scheduled to begin May 2; weather permitting.
- 600 Valley Hall Drive – A cross drain will be replaced. Construction is underway.
- 201 Mount Vernon Highway – Two storm pipes to be replaced. Construction scheduled to begin May 13; weather permitting.
- 185 Treadwick Drive – Catch basin to be sealed. Awaiting schedule from contractor.
- Glenridge Culvert North of Abernathy (at Marsh Creek) – Headwalls will be replaced and a culvert will be lined. Construction is scheduled to start in late May/early June.

- 600 North Harbor Drive – An emergency overflow structure will be modified and a floodwall will be built. The design engineer is preparing additional options to the floodwall, with recommendations forthcoming.
- 1107 Crest Valley Drive – A culvert will be replaced and a cross drain will be installed. Contractor is working on the upstream step pool and headwall veneer.

Environmental Court was held on May 3, 2019.

- There were 28 defendants scheduled to appear in court with 69 code, building, fire, or land violations.
 - Fourteen defendants with 33 charges were adjudicated with fines, probation or dismissals. Approximately \$17,254 in fines were assessed. The City was granted restitution of \$9,227.40 from C.W. Matthews Construction Company for damaged caused to property as a result of an obstruction of right-of-way and parking commercial vehicles.
 - Six defendants with nine charges failed to appear.
 - Eight defendants with 27 charges were reset for future court dates.
- 1620 Saddle Ridge-The lender appeared in court to produce a plan of action for a demolition or renovation of the property.
- Kitty Hawk Drive, Long Island Drive, Windsor Parkway- C.W. Matthews appeared in court to answer to the charges of storing construction equipment on the City Right-of-Way.
