The deadline for questions has passed. In reference to the RFP listed above, the following answers to questions, additions, deletions and changes are hereby incorporated into the RFP:

1. We are aware of the current and ongoing Trails Master Planning process the City and Sandy Springs Conservancy are undertaking with PATH Foundation and Kaizen Collaborative. We would like to understand how this proposed River Path and Access Master Plan is to be coordinated with the PATH Master Plan, and/or how this project deliverables are to be different from that project. It would appear on the surface, that these two projects could provide the same results. [The PATH project is not looking at trails along the river other than a short path under the Roswell Road bridge.](#)
1. In Section 3: Required Qualifications it is noted that “Project team shall be prequalified in each of the following areas:” Please confirm as noted in the pre-proposal meeting that there are no prequalification such as GDOT prequals required, rather the city is simply looking for people having experience with the 6 bullet points listed in Section 3. [The City does not require official certification, only experience.](#)
2. Under Section 3: Required Qualifications, the last bullet is “Location Studies” – please verify, as stated in the pre-proposal meeting, that this is referring to conceptual trail design, and not some other type of report. [Yes, for this project “Location Studies” refers to conceptual trail design.](#)
3. Will Mr. Tolbert be the city’s project manager for the duration of the project, or will this project be managed by a different person/ department within the city? [Catherine Mercier Baggett, the Planning and Zoning Manager for the City will lead this project after award.](#)
