Chad Z. DeFoor, CPM, CCIM - BIO

Chad DeFoor has over eleven (11) years of experience in multifamily property management, asset management, acquisitions, dispositions and brokerage with an emphasis in Class B and C multifamily product.

In January 2011, Chad joined **Apartment Realty Advisors (ARA)**, the largest privately held, full-service multifamily brokerage firm in the nation. Chad specializes in the listing and sale of Class B and C multifamily real estate for private and regional investors and during his short time at ARA has sold over 10,000 units, 39 properties, with a value in excess of \$325,000,000.

Prior to joining ARA, Chad was an Asset Manager for **TriMont Real Estate Advisors**, a third party special servicer based in Atlanta, GA (2005 – 2010). While at TriMont, Chad focused on multifamily REO asset management and dispositions for institutional and agency clients such as Fannie Mae and Lehman Brothers. While at TriMont Chad was responsible for the asset management and disposal of 120 REO multifamily properties (over 20,000 units across 22 states) with a value in excess of \$664,000,000.

From 2002 – 2005 Chad was a financial analyst at **JMG Realty**, a top 25 multifamily management company. While at JMG Chad was responsible for underwriting potential apartment acquisitions and took part in a training program that allowed him to work in every division of the company (onsite, accounting, construction and finally acquisitions).

In 2002 Chad received his undergraduate degree (BBA) from the University of Georgia where he double majored in both Real Estate and Marketing. While at Georgia, Chad was a member of the UGA Track Team (98-01) where he ran both the 400m dash and the 4x400m relay. Chad is a member of the Atlanta Chapter of CCIM and the Georgia Chapter of IREM, where he has obtained both his CCIM and CPM designations. Chad is also a member of the Atlanta Commercial Board of Realtors, the National Association of Realtors and is a licensed broker for the state of Georgia – 252279.
