ITEM: Recommendation to enter into Contract Agreement with Republic ITS (Siemens) for Traffic Signal/Sign Maintenance Services for the City of Sandy Springs

Background

Since July 1, 2011, the City of Sandy Springs has held a direct contract with Republic ITS (AKA Siemens) for Traffic Signal/Sign Maintenance Services.

Discussion

Republic ITS (Siemens) has provided these services for approximately four (4) years and wishes to provide continued services to the City for a term of one (1) year, upon City approval. The not to exceed value of the contract for FY14 is \$550,000, an increase of \$50,000 for materials to maintain the new City street lights.

Staff recommends awarding a contract extension to Republic ITS (Siemens) to sustain the current level of services and serve the residents of Sandy Springs. Since July 1, 2012 Siemens has completed over 530 work orders which ranged from replacing bulbs, traffic delay, signals in flash, signal head maintenance, overhead sign maintenance, emergency responses and after hour calls. They are also assisting with the Intersection Improvement Program, Phase 2, which is the installation of 71 internally illuminated street name signs.

Alternatives

Council could choose not to award a contract.

AMENDMENT NUMBER TWO

CONTRACT AGREEMENT

This Amendment (“Amendment”) is made and entered into this 1st of July , in the year 2013, by and between the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia, having its principle place of business at 7840 Roswell Road, Building 500, Sandy Springs, Georgia 30350 (“City”), and Republic Intelligent Transportation Services, Inc., 371 Bel Marin Keys Blvd #200, Novato, CA 94949 (“Contractor”);

WHEREAS, the City and the Contractor entered into that certain Contract Agreement, dated June 6, 2011 (“Contract Agreement”) and to provide Traffic Signal and Street Light Maintenance Services to the City;

WHEREAS, the parties have agreed that additional services will be provided as set forth in this Amendment;

NOW THEREFORE, in good and valuable consideration as set forth herein, the parties agree as follows:

The Parties agree that the Terms of the Contract Agreement shall be modified to include the following:

I. Article IV-Term

The Parties mutually agree that the term of the Contract shall be extended for one additional year beginning July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014.

II. Cost of Services

The Parties mutually agree that the contract shall be modified to include the cost of services in attachment named hereto as Exhibit A, Cost of Services.

The current Services of Contractor shall be carried on expeditiously, it being understood, however, that this Agreement may be extended or continued in force by the parties hereto in writing as provided herein.

III. Survival of Contract Agreement Terms

All other terms, provisions, and requirements as set forth in the Contract Agreement shall

continue in full force and effect. The execution of this Amendment does not in any manner waive, settle, or modify any of the obligations of the Contractor for the work completed under the Contract Agreement. Further, the terms, provisions, and requirements of the Contract Agreement shall apply to all as set forth in this Amendment. The Contractor expressly reaffirms that all warranties and representations of the Contract Agreement continue to be true and correct and that all bonds shall cover the Corrective Work as set forth in this Amendment.

IV. Governing Law

This Second Amendment shall be governed in all respects by the laws of the State of Georgia.

V. Entire Agreement

The Contract Agreement, as amended by this Amendment, constitutes the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter contained herein. Except for the terms and conditions of the Contract Agreement as set forth above, all prior agreements, representations, statements, negotiations, and undertakings are hereby superseded. Neither party has relied on any representation, promise, nor inducement not contained herein.

VI. Notices

All notices or other communications required or permitted to be given under this Second Amendment shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been duly given when delivered personally in hand, or when mailed by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested with proper postage prepaid, addressed to the appropriate party at the following address or such other address as may be given in writing to the parties:

**EXHIBIT A
COST OF SERVICES**

1. Traffic signal street light maintenance services:
 - 40 hours per week per crew
 - One (1) crew four days a week Monday to Thursday with one (1) Bucket Truck

2. Total Crew Cost: \$438, 70.00 annually
Material Allowance: \$100,000.00 total cost
Emergency Allowance: \$11, 250.00 total cost
Total annual cost: \$550,000.00

Each crew shall have a lead employee that is IMSA Certified for Level 1 Traffic Signal Technician within six (6) months of the commencement date of this amendment. An IMSA Certified Level 2 Traffic Signal Technician shall be assigned to this contract within six (6) months of the commencement date and shall serve as the lead employee on the bucket truck crew.

The City may acquire other services from the vendor as set forth below provided however no charges shall be authorized without written authorization from the city prior to such cost being incurred.
