**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A REVISED INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR THE DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF A UNIFIED RADIO SYSTEM AND TO AUTHORIZE CITY REPRESENTATIVES TO TAKE ACTIONS NECESSARY TO ENTER INTO PHASE II OF A CONTRACT WITH MOTOROLA FOR THE PURCHASE OF RADIO COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT.**

**WHEREAS**, on December 18, 2012, City Council authorized Sandy Springs (“City”) to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement for the Development and Implementation of a Unified Radio System (“System”) by and among the Cities of Alpharetta, Johns Creek, Milton, Roswell and Sandy Springs (“IGA”); and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Johns Creek has determined not to participate in the System, leaving the remaining Cities of Alpharetta, Milton, Roswell and Sandy Springs (“Participating Cities”) to develop and implement the System; and

**WHEREAS**, the IGA has been revised (“Revised IGA”), a copy of which is attached to this resolution, to reflect the following: (a) the removal of Johns Creek from participation in the System; (b) the reallocation of contribution shares to absorb the contribution anticipated to be made by Johns Creek; and additional minor changes; and

**WHEREAS**, the governing bodies of the Participating Cities have each authorized or are in the process of authorizing the Revised IGA; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 18, 2012, City Council by resolution authorized the City Manager to proceed with the purchase of equipment for the System by utilizing state contracts with Motorola, as provided by Georgia law, in order to take advantage of significant cost savings in equipment, as well as savings in the time and energy which would have been required by separate procurement; and

**WHEREAS**, Motorola agreed to provide additional cost savings pursuant to a phased approach, in which the first phase is the execution of an agreement with Motorola (“Motorola Agreement”) for the purchase of the core system for Sandy Springs (“Phase 1”) and the second phase is the execution by the remaining Participating Cities of the Motorola Agreement to purchase System requirements for unification of the System (“Phase 2”); and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Council’s authorization, the City Manager entered into Phase 1 of the Motorola Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Participating Cities now wish to enter into Phase 2 of the Motorola Agreement to allow the Participating Cities to develop and implement a unified System for the Participating Cities and making all Participating Cities subject to the terms and conditions of the Motorola Agreement;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of Sandy Springs as follows:

1. The Revised IGA, in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A, is hereby approved and the City Manager or the Mayor are hereby authorized to execute the Revised IGA on behalf of the City; and

2. The City Manager is authorized to enter into Phase 2 of the Motorola Agreement with all Participating Cities and is further authorized to execute, on behalf of the City, such documents as are necessary to proceed to Phase 2, including but not limited to amendments, change orders, etc., to the Motorola Agreement, as are consistent with the intent of this resolution; and

3. Funding shall be appropriated up to the City's full contribution share as described in the Revised IGA, including the City's allocated contribution share for Phase 2; and

4. The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to take such other action as may be necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.
