ITEM: Recommendation to enter into Contract Agreement with Georgia Management Agency, d/b/a Roadworx for Traffic Sign Maintenance Services for the City of Sandy Springs

## **Background**

Since July 1, 2011, the City of Sandy Springs has held a direct contract with Georgia Management Agency, d/b/a Roadworx for Traffic Sign Maintenance Services.

## **Discussion**

Georgia Management Agency, d/b/a Roadworx has provided these services for approximately four (4) years and wishes to provide continued services to the City for a term of one (1) year, with an option to renew, upon City approval. The not to exceed value of the contract for FY13 is \$300,000, the same amount as in FY2012.

Staff recommends awarding a contract extension to Georgia Management Agency, d/b/a Roadworx to sustain the current level of services and serve the residents of Sandy Springs.

## **Alternatives**

Council could choose not to award a contract.

**CONTRACT AMENDMENT**

**CONTRACT NUMBER AND TITLE: SERVICE AGREEMENT – TRAFFIC SIGN  
MAINTENANCE SERVICES**

**AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE**

**THIS AMENDMENT** to Contract is made and entered into as of the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2012 by and between the CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, (hereinafter referred to as “Sandy Springs”), and Georgia Management Agency dba Roadworx Inc., a corporation of the State of GEORGIA with offices located at 200 Bluff Oak Drive, Roswell, GA (hereinafter referred to as “Contractor”).

**RECITALS**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sandy Springs and Contractor entered into that certain contract agreement dated July 1, 2011, entitled Service Agreement, (the “Contract”);

**WHEREAS**, said Service Agreement provided for Contractor to provide certain Traffic Sign Maintenance Services (the “Services”) for the City;

**WHEREAS**, the original scope of services of the Contract included Traffic Sign Maintenance Services for the City of Sandy Springs, GA;

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual covenants set forth herein, the parties agree as follows:

**I. Article IV-Term**

The Parties mutually agree that the term of the Contract shall be extended for one additional year beginning July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013.

**II. Pricing**

The Parties mutually agree that the price of the Contract shall be modified to include an additional on-call emergency hourly rate of \$125 per hour or \$750 per day.

**III. Governing Law**

This First Amendment shall be governed in all respects by the laws of the State of Georgia.

**IV. Entire Agreement**

The Contract Agreement, as amended by this Amendment, constitutes the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter contained herein. Except for the terms and conditions of the Contract as set forth above, all prior agreements, representations, statements, negotiations, and undertakings are hereby superseded. Neither party has relied on any representation, promise, nor inducement not contained herein.

All other terms, provisions, and requirements, as set forth in the Contract shall continue in full force and effect. The execution of this Amendment does not in any manner waive, settle, or modify any of the obligations of the Contractor for the work completed under the Contract. Further, the terms, provisions, and requirements of the Contract shall apply to all as set forth in this Amendment. The Contractor expressly reaffirms that all warranties and representations of the Contract Agreement continue to be true and correct and that all bonds shall cover the Corrective Work as set forth in this Amendment.

**V. Notices**

All notices or other communications required or permitted to be given under this First Amendment shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been duly given when delivered personally in hand, or when mailed by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested with proper postage prepaid, addressed to the appropriate party at the following address or such other address as may be given in writing to the parties:




