
Work Session Meeting of the Sandy Springs City Council was held on Tuesday, April 17, 2012, at 7:00 p.m., Mayor Eva Galambos presiding.

STAFF DISCUSSION ITEMS

City Attorney

1. Updated City Fee Schedule

Revenue Supervisor Brandon Branham stated during staff's recent evaluation of the City fee schedule, it was noticed that changes needed to be made to the schedule. The necessary changes are ordinance numbers referenced on the schedule that are outdated and one fee amount that was changed by ordinance, but was not updated on the schedule.

Mayor Eva Galambos asked which fee amount was changed.

Revenue Supervisor Branham stated the adult establishment license fee was changed.

City Attorney Wendell Willard stated that fee was previously updated in the ordinance, but it was not updated in the fee schedule.

There was a consensus of Council to move this item forward to the consent agenda of the May 1, 2012, City Council regular meeting.

CITY COUNCIL DISCUSSION ITEMS

City Attorney Wendell Willard stated at the last Work Session meeting (April 3, 2012) there were two items recommended for submission in response to the Atlanta Regional Commission (ARC) Plan 2040 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) call for projects. Now, staff also recommends the Roswell Road/SR 9 at Glenridge Drive intersection improvement as an appropriate project to place on the request for ARC funding. This intersection is a major traffic issue, because many accidents have occurred there. This project should be placed as the first priority on the list.

Mayor Eva Galambos asked about the maximum amount of money that the City could receive for the project.

Director of Public Works Kevin Walter stated the maximum amount is a \$2 million grant. There will be a limited number of projects for North Fulton County, for which a consensus has to be received. The other North Fulton cities are suggesting two or three projects as well. The City should recommend this project along with the two projects discussed at the previous Council meeting. He believes the City would have a decent chance of having all of the projects included on the list.

Councilmember Karen Meinzen McEnerny asked about the other two projects.

Director of Public Works Walter stated the other two projects are the SR 9/ATMS project south of Abernathy Road and the bicycle/pedestrian plan.

There was a consensus of Council to include the Roswell Road/SR 9 at Glenridge Drive intersection improvement project on the Sandy Springs list for the ARC projects and to place it as the top priority.


