ITEM: Amendment of Subgrant Agreement with the Atlanta Regional Commission to extend Time of Performance for 10-year Update for Downtown Sandy Springs LCI

Public Works Department's Recommendation:

Public Works Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Council approve the Mayor to execute an amendment to the subgrant agreement with the Atlanta Regional Commission (ARC) for Livable Centers Initiative (LCI) Supplemental funds to extend the Time of Performance completion to September 30, 2012.

Background:

The Council approved entering into an agreement with ARC at its Regular Meeting on April 5, 2011, Agenda-Item-No.-11-071. The approved agreement indicated a Time of Performance completion of April 30, 2012.

Discussion:

The subgrant agreement must be modified to extend the contract with ARC to be eligible for a \$50,000 grant award for a 10-year update for the Downtown Sandy Springs LCI. The extension will allow the City to combine the Master Plan with the LCI Study procurement. The amendment will bring the completion date of the LCI closer in sync with the Master Plan.

AMENDMENT OF SUBGRANT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into as of this 29th day of February, 2012, by and between the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia (hereinafter referred to as the "Subgrantee") and the Atlanta Regional Commission, (hereinafter referred to as "ARC").

WITNESSETH THAT

WHEREAS, the parties hereto did enter into a subgrant agreement dated April 15, 2011, in which the Subgrantee agreed to perform certain services for ARC and ARC agreed to compensate the Subgrantee for the performance of such services, all as more fully set forth in said agreement; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend said subgrant agreement in certain respects as set forth herein below.

NOW, therefore and in consideration of the mutual benefits to the parties, the parties agree that said agreement is hereby amended as follows:

1. The last sentence of Section 3, Time of Performance, is hereby deleted and replaced with the following: "All work and services required hereunder shall be completed on or before September 30, 2012."

Except as specifically modified hereinabove, the remainder of said subgrant agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Subgrantee and ARC have hereunto agreed effective as of the date first above written.
