Agenda Item: **Resolution to Support the Disposition of the Belle Isle Apartments**

CMO (City Manager's Office) Recommendation:

APPROVAL of a resolution in support of the disposition of the Belle Isle Apartments, located at 151 Belle Isle Road, by the Housing Authority of Fulton County.

Background:

The Housing Authority of Fulton County owns a nine (9) unit apartment property known as Belle Isle Apartments located at 151 Belle Isle Road, Atlanta, Fulton County, Georgia. The purchase of the property was funded by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), and is designated as "public housing".

Discussion:

The Property continues to be funded through the Annual Contributions Contract (ACC), in exchange for a commitment from the Authority to maintain those units for low-income use under the system of rules that governs federally funded public housing. However, the units have outlived their usefulness and are obsolete as to physical condition, making it unsuitable for housing purposes, and no reasonable program of modifications is cost-effective to return the Property or portion of the Property to its useful life. Thus, authority wishes to seek permission from HUD to remove the Property through disposition from the ACC and thereby deregulate their use.

At this time, staff is recommending that the Mayor and City Council support the Housing Authority of Fulton County's request for disposition.

**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS,
GEORGIA, TO SUPPORT THE DISPOSITION OF BELLE ISLE APARTMENTS
151 Belle Isle Road, Sandy Springs, Fulton County, Georgia**

WHEREAS, the governing authority of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia (the “City”) has been informed by the Housing Authority of Fulton County (the “Authority”), as Owner, a public body corporate and politic, duly organized and validly existing pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Georgia (the “Authority”), that it is seeking permission from HUD to remove the Property through disposition from the ACC and thereby deregulate its use, said property located at 151 Belle Isle Road, Sandy Springs, Georgia, said project known as “the Property”; and

WHEREAS, the Authority believes it is in the best interest of the Authority to begin the disposition process with HUD to dispose of the Property; and

WHEREAS, the Authority seeks the approval of the City of Sandy Springs’ City Council (the “Council”) to proceed with the process of disposition of the Property; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia, and it is hereby resolved, only for the purposes of the Authority’s Application for Disposition of Belle Isle Apartments, by the authority of the same, that:

The City Council of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia supports, to the extent allowed by state and local laws, including full compliance with all applicable local zoning and land use regulations, the disposition of Belle Isle Apartments as proposed by the Housing Authority of Fulton County, Georgia, as Authority. This support is provided for the project as outlined herein.
