ITEM: Budget Amendment to Increase City Budget for FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program Award

Background:

FEMA has approved an award of \$110,000, with a federal share (80%) of \$88,000 and local share (20%) of \$22,000. This award provides funding to install sprinkler systems in Fire Stations 1 and 2.
