Background:

FEMA and GEMA have approved an award of \$2,749,364, with a federal share (75%) of \$2,060,023, state share (10%) of \$274,936 and local share (15%) of \$412,405. This award covers those properties determined to be *substantially damaged*. Each of the owners of the properties approved for purchase have voluntarily agreed to participate and understand that they are responsible for providing 15% of the cost of demolition and purchase. The properties approved by FEMA/GEMA and accepted by Council are:

- 4685 Hitching Post Trail, Sandy Springs, GA 30342-2815
- 505 Pine Forest Road, NE, Sandy Springs, GA 30342-2763
- 510 Pine Forest Road, NE, Sandy Springs, GA 30342-2764
- 520 Pine Forest Road, NE, Sandy Springs, GA 30342-2764
- 550 Pine Forest Road, NE, Sandy Springs, GA 30342-2764
- 6285 River Shore Parkway, Sandy Springs, GA 30328-3746

The City will not provide the 15% local matching share, as it will be provided by the homeowners during the buyout process.
