Agenda Item: Street Name Change – Heards Drive to Raider Drive

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***Department of Community Development Recommendation:***

Recommend **APPROVAL** of the street name change of Heards Drive and Heards Road to Raider Drive.

***Background:***

The staff of the Community Development Department was contacted by Edward H. Echols, on behalf of Riverwood International Charter School. The school would like to change the street name change from Heards Drive to Raider Drive. Heards Drive is located in Land Lots 166, 17th District, Sandy Springs, Georgia, on the south side of Heards Ferry and travels south for before intersecting with I-285.

***Discussion:***

The staff has reviewed the material submitted by the applicant and determined that all property owners immediately affected by the proposed street name change have been notified to the change. In addition, the staff has reviewed the Fulton County Street Name Database and determined that there is currently no Raider Drive within the County.

***Alternatives:***

- Extending the Heards Creek Drive road name across Heards Ferry Road to Powers Ferry Road intersection
- The Mayor and City Council could choose not to approve a street name change or could adopt a different street name from the one proposed.

***Financial Impact:***

New street signs will need to be purchased and installed by Riverwood International Charter School.

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**REQUEST**

The applicant is requesting a street name change based on the following:

This is the 2nd year that Riverwood has been a charter school. Part of the transition of becoming a charter school is the name change from Riverwood High School to Riverwood International Charter School. As part of this transition we would like to expand that change to be reflected in the street name change from **Heards Drive to Raider Drive** (scenario 5). Raider is the mascot for the school, hence the desire to rename the street Raider Drive.

## **BACKGROUND:**

The staff of the Community Development Department was contacted by Edward H. Echols, on behalf of Riverwood International Charter School. The school would like to change the street name from Heards Drive to Raider Drive. Heards Drive is located in Land Lots 166, 17th District, Sandy Springs, Georgia, on the south side of Heards Ferry and travels south for before intersecting with I-285.

The staff has reviewed the material submitted by the applicant and determined that all property owners immediately affected by the proposed street name change have been notified to the change. In addition, the staff has reviewed the Fulton County Street Name Database and determined that there is currently no Raider Drive within the County.

## **ANALYSIS:**

The City of Sandy Springs Code of Ordinances states the following:

Sec. 103-31. Assignment of names and address.

h. Changing of existing roadway names and addresses.

1. In any instance where the mayor and council, upon recommendation of the director of the department, determines that an existing road name may pose a threat to the public health, safety or welfare, the mayor and council on its own motion may change such roadway name after notice is given and a public hearing is held.

### *Finding:*

*There are currently two non-contiguous roads named Heards Drive off Heards Ferry Road. The current request is to change the name of the southern Heards Drive, which runs between Heards Ferry Road and I-285. Additionally, there is a street segment named Heards Road, with only one property addressed from it that runs between I-285 and Powers Ferry Road. Elimination of a duplicated non-contiguous roadway and clarifying the addressing would reduce the threat to the public health, safety and welfare. While staff supports the roadway name change from Heards Drive to Raider Drive, staff finds that the remaining segment named Heards Road should also be changed to further address the safety issue. Staff reviewed the request relative to assignment of names and address standards contained in Section 103-31 of Code of the Sandy Springs. Based upon this review, staff recommends **APPROVAL** of the street name change request subject to the following recommendations:*

- 1) Raider Drive (or another name) from Heards Ferry Road to Powers Ferry Road (Scenario 5).**
- 2) Extend Heards Creek Drive to Powers Ferry Road.**

- a. Notice of the proposed change and hearing date shall be given at least 25 days, but no more than 45 days, prior to the scheduled date of the mayor and council hearing on the proposed change.

*Finding:*

*The staff has advertised the proposed street name change and the hearing dates on August 24, 2010 and September 10, 2010. Therefore, staff is of the opinion this condition has been satisfied.*

- b. The department shall post a sign at approximately one mile intervals throughout the length of the roadway for which a name change is proposed and shall give notice by regular mail to the owners (according to the tax records of Sandy Springs) of each property which bears an address on the roadway for which a name change is proposed.

*Finding:*

*The Staff has posted two (2) signs at each end of the 2,055 foot road. Also, all property owners immediately affected by the proposed street name change have been notified to the change. Therefore, staff is of the opinion this condition has been satisfied.*

- c. Such signs and notices shall contain the time, date, place and purpose of the hearing, as well as a statement of the beginning and ending points of the segment of the roadway for which the name change is proposed. Notice shall not be considered inadequate if the signs are removed or mail is not delivered.

*Finding:*

*The Staff has posted two (2) signs at each end of the 2,055 foot road. Each sign advertises the proposed Street Name change and the public hearing date, time, and address of the public hearing. Therefore, staff is of the opinion this condition has been satisfied.*

**DEPARTMENT COMMENTS:**

The following departmental comments have been provided:

The street name changes have been reviewed by the Public Works Department, Police Department, Fire-Rescue Department and 911. Individual meetings were also held with City Council members. In addition, the Mayor and City Council were briefed regarding the proposed street name changes at the April 6, 2010 City Council Work Session.</li> </ul>
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Geographic Information Systems	GIS Analyst	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>GIS recommends extending Heards Creek Drive across Heards Ferry to Powers Ferry Road (scenario 1). The addresses on Heards Drive and Heards Road would be consistent with the addressing sequence of Heards Creek Drive, which would meet the safety concerns on this section of roadway.</li> </ul>
Public Safety	Deputy Police Chief	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Changing the entire Heards Drive/Road to Raider Drive is acceptable.</li> <li>Changing Heards Creek Drive and Mt Vernon Parkway all the way down to Powers Ferry Road again would actually make it less confusing. Both those roadways are continuous and changing Mt Vernon Parkway would eliminate confusion with Mt Vernon Road and Mt Vernon Circle on the east side of town.</li> <li>It would also reduce confusion with 911 while giving directions to the operator the current naming convention is complicated.</li> </ul>
	Senior Deputy Fire Marshall	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sandy Springs Fire Rescue considers how streets are named in the City critical because of the potential impact street names can have on our ability to quickly and effectively respond to emergencies. Our primary concerns are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Street names should not be duplicated within the City to avoid confusion, even if the suffix such as road or street is different.</li> <li>Street names should be easy to read, spell and pronounce – even for children in an emergency situation.</li> <li>Street names should apply to the entire length of the road even if it changes direction.</li> <li>Street names which have homonyms should not be used on any street even if the suffix is different. Example Steven Street, Stephan Street, Steven Court.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Public Works Department	Traffic Engineer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>We support the desire to change this road name. There are currently two non-contiguous roads named Heards Road. In addition the properties on this road are inconsistently addressed to Heards Rd and to Heards Dr. Elimination of a duplicated non-contiguous roadway and clarifying the addressing will have a positive impact on service delivery on both roads.</li> <li>The road name itself may lead to unintended consequences. As the Raiders are the local high school sports mascot as well as college and professional sports mascots, the number of incidents of the signs going missing is likely to increase. We have a similar problem with the street name signs on Rebel Trail. It may be worthwhile to consider setting aside funds to replace the signs that go missing, as their replacement does not fall within regular maintenance as we know they will go missing. Alternately, we can consider extending the Heards Creek Drive road name across Heards Ferry Road to the Powers Ferry Road intersection.</li> <li>We also have a problem with two non-contiguous sections of Powers Ferry Road and two intersections of Mount Vernon Highway with Powers Ferry Road. It may be worth considering extending the "Raiders Dr" or other street name to Mount Vernon Hwy to address other local way finding issues.</li> </ul>

**ALTERNATIVES:**

The applicant's request is to change Heards Drive to Raider Drive from Heards Ferry Road to I-285. However, staff is recommending extending the name change from Heards Ferry Road to Powers Ferry Road (scenario 5). This would create one-contiguous road name from Heards Ferry Road to Powers Ferry Road.

The City has also analyzed the follow alternatives:

**Extending the Heards Creek Drive road name across Heards Ferry Road to Powers Ferry Road intersection (scenario 1); or**

*Findings:*

*This alternative would eliminate the two non-contiguous road names. The current addresses along Heards Drive and Heards Road would be consistent with the addressing sequence of Heards Creek Drive. Therefore, staff supports this alternative.*

**Changing Heards Drive from the bridge crossing I- 285 to Heards Ferry Road to make the entire street length Heards Road from Powers Ferry Road to Heards Ferry Road (scenario 2); or**

*Findings:*

*This alternative would also eliminate the two non-contiguous road names and the inconsistency in addressing. However, changing only the suffix could potentially creating confusion and slow the ability to quickly and effectively respond to emergencies. Therefore, staff does not support this alternative.*

**Replace Heards Road by extending Powers Ferry Road to the bridge crossing I-285 (scenario 3); or**

*Findings:*

*This would create a stub out of Powers Ferry Road and it would form a continuous road with two different names, potentially creating confusion and slow the ability to quickly and effectively respond to emergencies. Therefore, staff does not support this alternative.*

**Extend Mount Vernon Parkway from Mount Vernon Highway to Heards Ferry Road (scenario 4).**

*Findings:*

*This alternative would also eliminate the two non-contiguous Heards Drive road names and the inconsistency in addressing. However, it would leave Powers Ferry Road with two non- contiguous roads, potentially creating confusion and slow the ability to quickly and effectively respond to emergencies. Therefore, staff does not support this alternative.*

**Changing Heards Drive from the bridge crossing I- 285 to Raider Drive and leave Heards Road from I-285 to Powers Ferry Road (scenario 6); or**

*Findings:*

*This alternative would also eliminate the two non-contiguous road names but, would not eliminate the inconsistency in addressing and could potentially create confusion and slow the ability to quickly and effectively respond to emergencies. Therefore, staff does not support this alternative.*

**The Mayor and City Council could choose not to approve a street name change or could adopt a different street name from the one proposed.**

**CONCLUSION:**


Staff reviewed the request relative to assignment of names and address standards contained in Section 103-31 of Code of the Sandy Springs. Based upon this review, staff recommends **APPROVAL** of the street name change request subject to the following recommendations:

- 1) Raider Drive (or another name) from Heards Ferry Road to Powers Ferry Road (scenario 5).
- 2) Extend Heards Creek Drive to Powers Ferry Road (scenario 1).



# Scenario 1: Extending Heards Creek Dr. to Powers Ferry Road




Scenario 2:  
Extending Heards Road north to Heards Ferry Road



Thank you for your help this morning and as you requested I am sending this email to reiterate our opposition to our portion of Heards Road NW being changed to Raider Drive.

To be clear, we are not opposed to that portion of the street from Heards Ferry to the 285 overpass being changed to a new name. Our concern is with our home address only. Our home is situated on the other side of the 285 overpass. Other than Riverwood High School and the fire station, we are the only house involved.

There are numerous reasons why it would not be desirable to change our address. My husband and I have lived at this address since December 1992 and have made considerable improvements to our property as well as being financially fiscal taxpayers.

The school address resides in the 30328 zip code and our house is in 30327. The natural division of the 285 overpass and the fact we reside in a different zip code, should be more than enough reason to exclude us from this name change.

We also **know** that it will be a financial burden on us to change the street name. Besides the family, friends, businesses who will need to be notified, we have invested a considerable amount of money into engraved stationary and printed business stationary. My husband has his office on the property....Mortgage Choice of Georgia.

We respectively hope you will take all of these factors into account when making a decision. We will be attending the City Council Meeting on June 15<sup>th</sup> to strongly voice our opposition to "our" street name being changed.
