ITEM: Consideration of Approval of a Contract to Construct the Spalding Drive Elementary School Sidewalks Project Subject to Validation and Approval by the Legal and Finance Departments

Public Works Department's Recommendation:

Bids were received on May 14, 2010 for the construction of sidewalks in the vicinity of Spalding Drive Elementary School on Dalrymple Road from Brandon Mill Road to Duncourtney Drive and on Brandon Mill Road from West Spalding Drive to Dalrymple Road. The results were:

7. ISC Inc.	\$545,981.00

Based upon bids and review of Contractor-provided references, staff recommends award to Precision 2000, Inc. in the amount of \$331,755.65.

Background:

This project includes construction of sidewalks and driveway tie-ins, storm drainage structures and piping, curbing, and associated retaining walls on the south side of Dalrymple Road and the east side of Brandon Mill Road in the vicinity of the Spalding Drive Elementary School.

Discussion:

The City's Capital Budget for this project totals \$500,000. The project was advertised for bids on April 22, 2010. A pre-bid conference for interested bidders was held on May 5, 2010.

Alternatives:

Two alternatives are:

1. Construct the project as bid
2. Not fund the project at this time and remove it from the Capital Sidewalks Program or delay the project for additional future funding consideration.

Financial Impact:

This project has \$500,000 available for construction in the City's FY10 Capital Sidewalk Budget.
